1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***  
3        **WHEREAS,** a group of about fifty-six high school students and advisors of the  
4        *Ritsumeikan* High School in Japan visited Guam for the purpose of showing respect  
5        and to offer prayers for those who died during World War II; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the *Ritsumeikan* High School students and advisors visited World  
2 War II related sites on Guam, including the War in the Pacific National Park overlook  
3 on Nimitz Hill, *Ga'an* Point in the village of *Agat*, the *Merizo* Massacre sites, the  
4 *Mannengon* Memorial Site in the village of *Yona*, and the South Pacific Memorial  
5 Park in *Yigo*, in order to pay tribute and give prayers for those who died at these and  
6 other related sites on Guam; and

7           **WHEREAS**, this visit and show of respect by the students and advisors of  
8 *Ritsumeikan* High School from Japan is primarily to call on sites where World War II  
9 battles were fought; and

10          **WHEREAS**, it is hoped that this will become an annual trip, and that the  
11 tribute made by the students and advisors of *Ritsumeikan* High School shines as an  
12 example that will encourage other members of organizations from Japan to make  
13 similar trips; and

14          **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Explore & Study, Inc., has been instrumental in the  
15 efforts to heal the wounds of World War II, and the tensions created as a result of the  
16 war, between the people of Japan, Guam, and the United States, and has held  
17 ceremonies and tributes in the past years with that noble aim in mind; and

18          **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Explore & Study, Inc., along with its President, Mr. Ken  
19 Haga, have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals, and especially to  
20 help organize this trip by the students and advisors of the *Ritsumeikan* High School  
21 from Japan; now therefore, be it

22          **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*  
23 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
24 of Guam, highly commend and humbly thank the principal, teachers, and students of  
25 *Ritsumeikan* High School from Japan for visiting Guam and the World War II sites,  
26 and for honoring, praying, and paying tribute to those who lost their lives at these

1 World War II sites; and does further thank the U.S. Explore & Study, Inc., for its work  
2 on the project; and be it further


