1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the 44th Aerial Port Squadron, which was originally named the
4 349th Aerial Port Flight, Detachment 1, was activated on March 21, 1981; and there
5 were over sixty charter members sworn into duty. The inception of the U.S. Air Force

1 Reserve was realized with the commitment and vision of Chief Master Sergeant
2 Tomas Q. Fernandez, a retired service member of the United States Air Force, whose
3 career in the U.S. Air Force played a critical role in formulating this notable unit on
4 the island of Guam; and

5 **WHEREAS**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognizes Chief Master Sergeant Tomas
6 Q Fernandez for his unwavering commitment to establishing a U.S. Air Force Reserve
7 squadron on Guam by actively working with the former Commander of the Fourth Air
8 Force at McClellan Air Force Base in California, former Governor Paul Calvo, and
9 the Members of the Sixteenth Guam Legislature to advocate for the need to establish a
10 U.S. Air Force Reserve squadron on Guam; and

11 **WHEREAS**, since its inception, the U.S. Air Force Reserve on Guam has been
12 instrumental in further upholding the freedom and defense of our island and nation.
13 The U.S. Air Force Reserve has been recognized for its exceptional service to our
14 island community. In 1994, the unit was a recipient of the award for “Best in the
15 Pacific,” when it was distinguished as the “Air Reserve Command’s Aerial Port of the
16 Year”; and *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further commends the unit for again earning this
17 award in 1996, 2002, 2004 and 2006; and


18 **WHEREAS**, today, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognizes the more than two
19 hundred thirty members of the U.S. Air Force Reserve on Guam for their dedication
20 and bravery as they continue to answer our nation’s call to serve in support of the
21 Global War on Terrorism; and

22 **WHEREAS**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* also calls attention to the continued
23 community efforts that the U.S. Air Force Reserve engages in to further support our
24 island’s well-being during times of natural disasters; as well as the numerous civic
25 efforts that the U.S. Air Force Reserve embarks on to further improve the quality of
26 life for the people of Guam; now therefore, be it

2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
3 of Guam, recognize and congratulate the 44th Aerial Port Squadron on the Thirty-third

5 and women of the U.S. Air Force Reserve on Guam for their service to our island and
