

**Relative to recognizing and honoring the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas, former Senator, for his achievements, accomplishments and service to the people of Guam; and to further extending condolences to his family on behalf of the people of Guam.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas, affectionately known to  
4 his friends and family as “Rick”, was born on November 14, 1923, in *Hagåtña*,  
5 Guam, the son of the late Jose Santos and the late Clotilde Santos Salas; and he  
6 was called to his eternal rest on April 4, 2014; and

7           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas developed a solid work  
8 ethic as a child, learning from his parents and family; and this is evident as he  
9 would traverse the streets of *Hagåtña* selling freshly baked goods to help his

1 family; and he would further assist his father and brother in their architecture  
2 and land surveying profession; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in May 1949, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas graduated  
4 from Doane College in Crete, Nebraska, with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in  
5 Business; and

6 **WHEREAS**, during his pursuit of higher education, the late Honorable  
7 G. Ricardo Salas would work various odd jobs to provide financial assistance to his  
8 family, especially his brother, Sergio, who was pursuing a degree in medicine; and

9 **WHEREAS**, after earning his college degree, the late Honorable G.  
10 Ricardo Salas returned home to take care of his ailing father; and

11 **WHEREAS**, on November 26, 1951, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas  
12 married the late Rosa Teresita Perez in a ceremony officiated by the late Father  
13 Cyril Langheim, OFM, Cap. at the *Dulce Nombre de Maria* Cathedral in  
14 *Hagåtña*; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the children of the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas and his  
16 late wife, Rosa, are: Richard Conrad Sr.; Melissa; Ronald John; Kathleen  
17 Angelica; Lucina Elaine; Teresita Marie; Vicente Ramon; and Solange Mirim;  
18 in addition, they reared their first grandchild, Richard Conrad Jr. (“Ricky  
19 Boy”); and they were also blessed with nineteen grandchildren and three great-  
20 grandchildren; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas had a long and  
22 successful career in both the public and private sectors, having worked at the  
23 Department of Land Management, the Department of Revenue and Taxation, and  
24 the Bank of America; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas was an active member  
26 of the Republican Party of Guam, and he was selected to serve as a delegate to  
27 the Republican National Convention in 1972; and he was one of the few people from

1 Guam who received a formal invitation to attend the inauguration of President Richard  
2 M. Nixon in January of 1973; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas answered the call of the  
4 people to seek elected public office, and he served as a Senator in the 8<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>  
5 and 13<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislatures; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas founded and  
7 successfully operated several business ventures, specifically, the Salas Agency  
8 Corporation, Salas Surveying Services, and Salas Equipment Co., which he  
9 managed from 1972 to 2005; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas was well-respected,  
11 both locally and internationally, for his expertise in the area of real estate; and  
12 he had clientele throughout the Pacific region and Asia; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas was known for his  
14 generous heart, especially for his contributions to the Carmelite nuns and the  
15 *Dulce Nombre de Maria* Cathedral-Basilica; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas, having learned early in  
17 life the values of discipline, commitment, integrity, and the importance of  
18 pursuing a higher education, instilled these values, morals and ethics in his children  
19 and grandchildren; and he furthered sacrificed his life of luxury to support their  
20 education and career paths; and


21 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas was a kind and generous  
22 husband, father, grandfather, great grandfather, and friend; and he was forever  
23 loyal to those he loved; now therefore, be it

24 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does  
25 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and honor the late Honorable  
26 G. Ricardo (Rick) Salas, former Senator, for his many achievements,

1 accomplishments, and service to the people of Guam; and does further extend  
2 sincere condolences to his family on his passing; and be it further

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest  
4 to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to  
5 children of the late Honorable G. Ricardo Salas, former Senator; and to the  
6 Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.
