WHEREAS, Elisa Crisostomo Tedtaotao was born on April 15, 1939, and she is originally from the village of *Isangjan*, and

WHEREAS, Elisa is the daughter of the late Antonia T. Camacho; and she is the second of eight (8) children, with four (4) sisters and three (3) brothers; and

WHEREAS, in 1956, Elisa married Raymondo T. Taimanglo at the Saint Joseph Catholic Church in *Isangjan*; and

WHEREAS, Elisa had developed her career as a strong *Chamorro* woman, and she was an active and supportive wife and mother; and

WHEREAS, Elisa shared her life in her eleven (11) children: Ray Jr., Hilda, Eddie, Evelyn, Jobanna, Therese, Betty, Sherry, Arthur, Donna, and Jerry; and

WHEREAS, in 1966, the Taimanglo family moved to *Makobjoj*; and after settling there, they became prominent members of the church and village community; and

WHEREAS, being a product of her generation, Elisa was never fully employed, although her full time employment was in her work as a "stay-at-home" mom; and she was well known for her active involvement in her civic contributions and her faithful devotion to the *San Isidro* Catholic Church, where she was a devoted parish member and section leader of the *San Isidro* Parish Christian Mothers, and a faithful Eucharistic Minister and Sacristan; and

WHEREAS, Elisa was also a part of the community support for the Carmelite Nuns while they were based in *Makobjoj*, often offering her assistance and services when it was needed; and

WHEREAS, Elisa's care for the well-being of her eleven (11) children was unwavering as she was a loyal and active volunteer for her children's many school activities and functions; and

WHEREAS, Elisa's religious and community involvement extended to the various volunteer services she contributed, such as serving as a member of the 1970 Queen's Committee, as the Treasurer of the *Isangjan* SPIMA Senior Citizens Center, as a member of the Democratic Women's Association; and as a member of the Guam Plant Nurserymen's Association; and

WHEREAS, Elisa's green thumb has contributed to beautification causes in the village, specifically at the *San Isidro* Church grounds and building interior, as well as throughout her home and children's home, as she propagates her prized plant possessions to family and friends to enjoy the fruits of her labor; and

WHEREAS, Elisa is also known for her cooking of *Chamorro* delicacies, with her children and grandchildren wanting more of her red rice, corn soup and *tsokikien*; and

WHEREAS, Elisa is the proud grandmother of twenty-eight (28) grandchildren; and a proud great-grandmother of forty-six (46) great-grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, with her positive and active lifestyle, Elisa continues to involve herself in serving her church and village community by participating in the many activities, while encouraging her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren to follow in her footsteps; now therefore, be it
