3        **WHEREAS,** the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair is the annual signature  
4        cultural event of the Guam Visitors Bureau, showcasing the vibrant cultures of  
5        Micronesia; and

6        **WHEREAS,** for the last quarter century, delegations from the Federated  
7        States of Micronesia; Rota, Saipan and Tinian of the Commonwealth of the

1 Northern Mariana Islands; and the Republics of Kiribati, Nauru, the Marshall  
2 Islands, and Palau, have gathered on Guam to commemorate the largest cultural  
3 event in the region; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair showcases Micronesia’s  
5 master carvers, blacksmiths, traditional fishing experts, jewelers, weavers, dancers,  
6 musicians, and chefs; and it allows visitors to the Fair the opportunity to experience  
7 first-hand the customs that have been passed down and perpetuated through many  
8 generations; and

9 **WHEREAS**, twenty-seven years ago, on August 26, 1987, the Honorable  
10 Joseph F. Ada, Governor of Guam, signed Substitute Bill No. 464 (LS) into law as  
11 Public Law No. 19-7, establishing the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair; and

12 **WHEREAS**, upon his transmission of Public Law No. 19-7 to *I Liheslaturan*  
13 *Guåhan*, Governor Ada anticipated “a future of greater cooperation between the  
14 people who share the common heritage of this beautiful and bountiful Pacific  
15 Ocean”; and


16 **WHEREAS**, the island of Guam is proud to host our brothers and sisters
