Arriola was admitted to practice law before the Supreme Court of the State of Minnesota in 1953; the U.S. District Court of Guam, also in 1953; the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in San Francisco in 1957; the United States Supreme Court in 1969; the U.S. District Court of the Northern Marianas in 1978; and the Supreme and Superior Courts of the Northern Marianas. He is also a member of the Guam Bar Association, the American Bar Association, and the International Bar Association; and
