2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, in 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed a proclamation
4 designating May 15 as, “Peace Officers Memorial Day”; and the week in which that
5 date falls as, “Police Week.” During the commemoration of “Police Week,” law

1 enforcement officers from around the world participate in a number of planned events
2 which honor those that have paid the ultimate sacrifice, and recognize the
3 commitment of law enforcement officers; and

4 **WHEREAS**, “National Police Week” is celebrated from May 13 to May 19,
5 2014, as a tribute to the courageous men and women in law enforcement who continue
6 to uphold the protection and justice of the communities they dedicatedly serve; and

7 **WHEREAS**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further acknowledges the commitment of
8 our law enforcement officers on Guam as they celebrate the “2014 Guam Police
9 Week,” from May 11 to May 17, 2014. The law enforcement officers of Guam
10 continue to serve the people of Guam by actively participating in coordinated efforts
11 to build a stronger force to combat crime on Guam; and

12 **WHEREAS**, as we anticipate the changes set on our horizon we can always
13 depend on the support and services of our local and federal law enforcement officers
14 as they perform essential functions in protecting and serving our island community ;
15 and

16 **WHEREAS**, during the “2014 Guam Police Week,” several activities are held
17 to gain the participation of our island community so that they may understand the
18 types of services that our law enforcement officers on Guam provide to our people.
19 The Guam Police Department will hold educational activities, public awareness
20 campaigns, a memorial service to honor our fallen GPD officers, and several
21 recognition events to honor the dedication of the men and women of the Guam Police
22 Department; and

23 **WHEREAS**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further thanks the Guam Police
24 Department, the Port Authority of Guam Police, the A.B Won Pat International
25 Airport Authority Police, and other local and federal law enforcement officers for

1 safeguarding our island; and further pays tribute to them as they celebrate the “2014
2 Guam Police Week”; now therefore, be it


3 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
