WHEREAS, in 1986, Mr. Caseres began his career with the government of Guam serving as a Planner I with the Guam Coastal Management Program (GCMP), Bureau of Planning; and

WHEREAS, through Ray's outstanding performance of the job tasks he was assigned, he was promoted to a Planner II, in 2004; and promoted again to a Planner III, in 2013; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ray Caseres has served under eight executive branch administrations, with three Governors serving two consecutive four year terms; he has served under nine Directors, and had been with the Agency when it went through a name change from the Bureau of Planning, and saw the merger of the Department of Commerce and the Guam Health Planning Division to the Bureau of Statistics and Plans; and


