1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS, in 1906, G.H. (David) Atkins and Clifton Kroll established**  
4 **Atkins, Kroll and Co., Ltd. in San Francisco, California, and began trading operations**

1 between the United States and Australia. This business extended to the Pacific Islands  
2 and in 1914, Atkins Kroll was established on Guam to coordinate the growing copra  
3 trade in the Marianas. Due to the positive impact Atkins Kroll had on our island, other  
4 subsidiary companies were subsequently established in the Philippines, Saipan, and  
5 Singapore; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Atkins Kroll's operations in the Pacific region were then  
7 interrupted by the onset of World War II. However, after the war, company officials  
8 returned to Guam and discovered that loyal Guamanian employees had secretly  
9 preserved the company's records. This enabled the company to continue on with their  
10 success. Not only did the company prosper after the war, but Guam's economy also  
11 prospered due to the major role Atkins Kroll had in rebuilding and developing our  
12 island; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in 1974, Atkins Kroll joined the Inchcape Group, an international  
14 motors distributor headquartered in London. Atkins Kroll and Inchcape's core values  
15 intertwined with one another: *always* putting the customer at the center of everything  
16 they do, bringing them only the very best automobiles and services in the industry;  
17 and

18 **WHEREAS**, a few years later, in 1981, it became apparent that the hub of  
19 Atkins Kroll's business was in the Pacific, mainly on Guam. The services that AK  
20 provided on our island exceeded the company's expectations; although the company  
21 had started in California, the San Francisco office was closed down and trading  
22 operations were concentrated in the Guam-Micronesia region; and

23 **WHEREAS**, today, Atkins Kroll, Inc. is the leading distributor of vehicles in  
24 this part of the world, and it is the oldest corporation on our island. By creating a  
25 network of outlets throughout Guam, the Northern Marianas, and Micronesia, Atkins

1 Kroll is able to reach a vast community in hopes of providing a full range of motoring  
2 services to this region. Atkins Kroll *believes* that its longevity and business success is  
3 due to the company's efforts in providing quality products and services that customers  
4 value; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Atkins Kroll is a major brand in the local business community,  
6 and is the leading automotive dealership on Guam representing Toyota, Scion,  
7 Chevrolet, Lexus, and AC Delco. Aside from their vehicles and automotive products,  
8 AK's main essence is customer service. The mission statement of the company  
9 revolves around the people of Guam: "Alongside the technology and innovation of our  
10 products, and the pride and reputation of our local people, it is our mission to provide  
11 customer service excellence...every day." Atkins Kroll is the brand that customers can  
12 rely on first and foremost for their automotive needs; and

13 **WHEREAS**, AK's corporate theme, "Here for Guam. Here for life," reflects  
14 highly on their acts of kindness to not only consumers, but also to the vulnerable  
15 people of our island community. Atkins Kroll is highly involved with the people of  
16 Guam through their generous donations, which includes, but is not limited to, the  
17 Make-A-Wish Foundation, the American Red Cross, the Guam Memorial Hospital  
18 Volunteers Association, and the United Service Organizations; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Atkins Kroll exists to provide the community of Guam absolute  
20 customer service excellence while maintaining their highly valued reputation on our  
21 island. Atkins Kroll believes in the importance of providing customers with the best  
22 products and services in the automotive industry. The company hires only qualified  
23 associates who can perform to the highest standard of quality and service in order to  
24 be aligned with Atkins Kroll's goals. Atkins Kroll associates believe that the truest

1 strength of the company is customer service, while providing quality products.  
2 Customers appreciate every effort made towards customer service; and

3         **WHEREAS**, Atkins Kroll continues to make a difference in our community  
4 through their commitment to corporate partnership and service to our island. Decade  
5 after decade, AK has provided quality automotive products, while continuing to  
6 donate their time and resources to great causes. In honor of Atkins Kroll's 100<sup>th</sup> Year  
7 Anniversary, the company decided to donate twenty-five (25) vehicles to help support  
8 efforts against crime-related issues, such as burglaries, drugs/substance abuse, and  
9 other village concerns. Additionally, Atkins Kroll will donate \$1,914 every month this

21 *Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the company for being a significant partner in the  
22 growth of Guam's economic prosperity; and does further acknowledge the dedicated  
23 AK workforce for "Leading the Way, Every Day" with their exemplary customer  
24 service; and be it further

1           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules  
2 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
