2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS, forty (40) years ago, sometime around 1971, the first group of**
4 **Korean nationals came to Guam, creating the first bridge connecting the two Pacific**

1 peoples that has helped influence a positive impact on our island, and has also helped
2 shape Guam's culture; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in October 1973, the Korean Association of Guam (KAG) was
4 established by many prominent business leaders, who served as its founding members;
5 and

6 **WHEREAS**, the mission of the Korean Association of Guam is to help
7 families, friends, and other Korean-Americans in our community, through its various
8 services, such as providing shelter and comfort to homeless Korean elderly persons;
9 and through their promotion of the Korean culture, traditions, and its native language,
10 by educating students at the Korean School of Guam; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Korean Association of Guam exists to assist and advocate for
12 Koreans, and Korean-Americans, in adapting their lifestyles on Guam, and to provide
13 charity work to benefit local charitable organizations. They are constantly involved in
14 our island community through their participation in the annual Liberation Day Parade,
15 the Road Adoption Program, and the Harvest Ministry; and

16 **WHEREAS**, through the hard work and perseverance of the KAG members,
17 the Korean culture is evident throughout our island, thus making Guam a satisfying
18 destination to visitors coming from South Korea. The Korean Association of Guam
19 has made major contributions to our community, specifically in the tourism industry,
20 as our island continues to progress in the Korean travel trade; and


21 **WHEREAS**, tourism has long been understood to be a vital component of
22 Guam's economy; and as relations between the people of Guam and Korea have
23 continued to expand, Korea has now become our second most important visitor
24 market. The Korean Association of Guam continues to build on Guam's attraction to
25 the Korean market through the participation in the "Korean Festival," which is hosted
26 by our island community; and

8 of Guam, recognize and congratulate the Korean Association of Guam (KAG) on the

10 *Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the Korean Association of Guam for influencing
11 and enriching Guam's culture and appeal through its unique contributions to our
