Relative to recognizing and memorializing the late Honorable Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja, former Mayor of *Chalan Pago-Ordó*, for his many achievements and accomplishments; and to further extending sincere and humble condolences to his family, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Mayor Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja was born on
4 July 1, 1928; and he was called to his eternal reward on Friday, May 30, 2014, at the
5 age of eighty-five (85); and

6 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Mayor Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja is the son of
7 †Francisco Borja Borja and †Ana Benavente Iriarte Borja; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Mayor Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja married
2 †Maria Crisostomo Arceo, his wife of sixty-two (62) years, on July 7, 1951; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Mayor Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja and †Maria
4 Crisostomo Arceo Borja were blessed with seven (7) children - four (4) boys: Frank,
5 †Reverend Deacon Eddie, Peter, and †Lawrence; and three (3) girls: Maria, Patsy, and
6 Jennifer; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in 2004, the late Honorable Mayor Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja was
8 elected to serve as Mayor of the municipality of *Chalan Pago-Ordot*; and he proudly
9 served the people of *Chalan Pago-Ordot* from January 2005 to January 2009; and

10 **WHEREAS**, during his four (4) year tenure as Mayor and as a man of service
11 and progress, the late Honorable Mayor Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja was instrumental in
12 improving the facilities at the Jose Atoigue Park, and honoring the fallen soldiers of
13 the municipality by erecting monuments in their memory; and

14 **WHEREAS**, in 1952, prior to serving the people of *Chalan Pago-Ordot* as
15 Mayor, the late Honorable Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja attended the Territorial College
16 of Guam (now the University of Guam), and he had the opportunity to serve as its
17 Student Body President; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja enlisted in the U.S.
19 Navy and served in the Korean War; and he was honorably discharged in 1956; and

20 **WHEREAS**, after his return to Guam, from 1956 to 1967, the late Honorable
21 Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja worked at the Navy Public Works Center (PWC), the Ship
22 Repair Facility (SRF), the U.S. Post Office, and the National Aeronautics and Space
23 Administration (NASA). He later joined the Military Sealift Merchant Marine in
24 1967; and

1 **WHEREAS**, upon his return to Guam, the late Honorable Pedro “Pete” Iriarte
2 Borja worked at the Navy PWC *Piti* Power Plant, during which he served as President
3 of the PWC Recreation and Welfare Center, and had coordinated the softball league
4 for several years. He retired as a civil servant after thirty (30) years of dedicated
5 service; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja devoted much of his
7 time in support of the senior citizens’ activities in *Ordot*, and he was instrumental in
8 developing the recreational “*Ordot* Community Advancement Association (OCAA)
9 Bingo” operation for many years, in order to help raise funds for the San Juan Bautista
10 Church parish in *Ordot*; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja served as the
12 Director for “Tita’s Day Care Center” in *Chalan Pago*, which was a business his wife
13 owned and operated for fourteen (14) years, and where he was fondly known as “Papa
14 Pete”; and

15 **WHEREAS**, during his years working as a day care provider, the late
16 Honorable Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja remained an active member of the Guam
17 Caregiver’s Association, where he served as the Treasurer; and in his spare time he
18 would be seen working on church projects, as well as assisting others in the parish
19 community; and

20 **WHEREAS**, during his tenure in public office, the late Honorable Pedro “Pete”
21 Iriarte Borja served the people of *Chalan Pago-Ordot* in a most honorable and
22 exemplary manner, ensuring that the health, safety, and general well-being of the
23 residents of *Chalan Pago-Ordot* were attended to; and

24 **WHEREAS**, from 2010 to 2012, the late Honorable Mayor Pedro “Pete” Iriarte
25 Borja served as President of the Korean War Veterans Association, and he was
26 recognized as the “Veteran of the Year” in 2011; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja was a man of
2 compassion and honor who had a passion for helping others; and whose passing will
3 leave a void that will be felt for many years to come, in both the family he loved and
4 the island he so proudly served; now therefore, be it


5 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
6 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
7 of Guam, recognize and memorialize the late Honorable Pedro “Pete” Iriarte Borja,
8 former Mayor of *Chalan Pago-Ordot*, for his many achievements and
9 accomplishments; and does further extend sincere and humble condolences to his
10 family on his passing; and be it further

11 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
12 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
13 the same be thereafter transmitted to the family of the late Honorable Pedro “Pete”
14 Iriarte Borja; to the Mayors Council of Guam; and to the Honorable Edward J.B.
15 Calvo, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.
