1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN***
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Leonardo San Nicolas Paulino, also known
4 as Leonard, was born on September 20, 1925; and he was called to his eternal
5 reward on Friday, May 23, 2014, in Yukon, Oklahoma, at the age of eighty-eight
6 (88); and

1 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Leonardo San Nicolas Paulino is the son of
2 †Vicente T. Paulino and †Ana San Nicolas Paulino; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Leonardo San Nicolas Paulino fell in love
4 and married Cleotilde Cruz Camacho, his wife of sixty-seven (67) years, on June 26,
5 1947; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Leonardo San Nicolas Paulino and Cleotilde
7 Camacho Paulino were blessed with thirteen (13) children - seven (7) boys:
8 †Andrew, Leonard, †James, Vincent, Gerard, Gino, and Roy; and six (6) girls:
9 †Cresencia, Alvina, Margaret, †Geraldine, Elaine, and Mildred; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Leonardo San Nicolas Paulino was a
11 graduate of George Washington High School; and he eventually became a proprietor
12 and manager of his own company, the Whitehouse Market and Apartments; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Leonardo San Nicolas Paulino was selected
14 as the Valedictorian of his high school class; and as a result, he was personally
15 chosen to attend the Guam Teacher Training Program, and he eventually became a
16 school teacher, and served with the Guam Department of Education from 1949 to
17 1950; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Leonardo San Nicolas Paulino was a devoted
19 and steadfast supporter of the community through his many contributions as the
20 President of the Holy Name Society of *Agaña*, from 1956 to 1957; as a member of
21 the Board of Directors for the Tuberculosis and Health Association, where he served
22 as Chairman of the Finance Committee and Treasurer from 1964 to 1967; and he
23 was President of the *Agaña* Cathedral Grade School-Academy of Our Lady Parent
24 Teacher Association (PTA) from 1967 to 1968; and

1 **WHEREAS**, from 1967 to 1972, the late Honorable Leonardo San Nicolas
2 Paulino began his political career when he was elected to serve as a Senator in the
3 9th, 10th, and 11th Guam Legislatures, chairing the Legislature’s Committee on
4 Housing and Urban Development; serving as Vice Chairman of the Committee on
5 Agriculture and Fisheries; and serving as a member of the Committee on Rules, the
6 Committee on Finance and Taxation, and the Committee on District Representation;
7 and

8 **WHEREAS**, in the years following his political career, the late Honorable
9 Leonardo San Nicolas Paulino continued in his public service as Director of the
10 Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority for six (6) years; and served as the
11 Chairman of the Guam Democratic Committee and the Liberation of Guam
12 Committee; and

13 **WHEREAS**, after relocating off island, the late Honorable Leonardo San
14 Nicolas Paulino remained deeply involved in several charity associations, and he
15 devoted much of his free time to the Guam *Chamorro* Community and the St. John
16 Neumann Catholic Church of North Las Vegas, Nevada; and


17 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Leonardo San Nicolas Paulino will always
18 be fondly remembered for his humble and caring heart; and for his passion to caring
19 for the well-being of the family he loved, and the people he so proudly served; now
20 therefore, be it

24 Proprietor, for his extensive achievements and accomplishments; and does further


1 extend sincere and humble condolences to his family on his passing; and be it
