Mercado for his ten years of leadership to the Apalit Association of Guam (AAG); and to further extending a warm and sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to him for his benevolence and generosity in sharing his time, talents, and treasures, which are anchored on the noble intention to spread spirituality and devotion to St. Peter, with his brothers and sisters on Guam.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* 2 *MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, in 1995, Mr. Ignacio L. Mercado and his family first set foot on Guam as immigrants; and he began to actively attend the annual Feast of St. Peter with his fellow Apaliteños, until he was requested to form an association in 2003; and 1 WHEREAS, in 2004, Mr. Mercado, as the "*Hermano* Mayor" of the annual 2 Feast, started inviting the public to the devotion to St. Peter through radio 3 announcements; and he initiated the nine-day novena at the Santa Barbara Parish in 4 *Dededo*. That was the same year that the historical Typhoon *Tingting* passed near 5 Guam; however, Mr. Mercado and his colleagues continued with the celebrations, 6 covering the pavilion with tents and courageously withstanding the strong winds and 7 record-breaking rains; and

8 WHEREAS, in 2005, under Mr. Mercado's continuing leadership, the Apalit 9 Association of Guam was formally established; and

WHEREAS, in 2006, Mr. Mercado wanted to relive his hometown tradition,
and he brought a grand statue of St. Peter from the Philippines, with the supporting
efforts of the Association's members; and

WHEREAS, in 2007, Father Paul Gofigan was invited to the Mercado
residence to inaugurate the statue of St. Peter; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, with Mr. Mercado at the helm, the annual celebrations caught more attention from the community with its banquet-style ceremony, and was also highlighted by the blessings given by Father Patrick Garcia; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, Mr. Mercado gave recognition plaques in appreciation to
all the past "*Hermano* Mayors." He also invited the Philippine Consul General, Olivia
V. Palala, and Consulate staff, and proposed a full commemoration of the traditional
celebration of the Apaliteños. The inspiring Mr. Mercado further reenacted the "*libad*"
(fluvial parade); and sought the permission of the Guam Department of Agriculture to
hold it on Guam's shores; and

WHEREAS, in 2010, the zeal and passion that Mr. Mercado has for St. Peter made major headways for the Association. The festivity was recognized by the Philippine Consulate Office and the Filipino Community of Guam as an annual culminating activity of the Philippine Independence Day celebrations. Invited to the
 event was Father Dan Bien, who inaugurated the makeshift barge where St. Peter was
 put onboard and pulled by devotees along the waters of *Ypao* and *Matapang* beach
 while the music from the Guam Territorial Band played. This marked the first Fluvial
 Procession in the history of Guam; and

6 WHEREAS, in 2011, Mr. Mercado reached out to more devotees and invited 7 Father Paul Gofigan to speak at the first Mass held for the yearly program which was 8 called, "The Water Festival: Apalit Association of Guam Celebrates its Patron St. 9 Peter"; and which attracted many people from various communities, including, 10 legislators, associations, tourists, and the Pacific Daily News; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, Mr. Mercardo invited Father Jason, the Archdiocese of
 Agaña, Guam, to participate in the celebration of the Mass. This activity was again
 featured in Pacific Daily News "Fluvial Procession of Patron St. Peter"; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, with Mr. Mercado's steadfastness and devotion, the
Fiesta was highlighted by a Mass celebrated by the Most Reverend Anthony Sablan
Apuron, O.F.M., Cap., D.D., Archbishop of Guam; and

17 WHEREAS, through the initiatives of Mr. Mercado, the Association became 18 actively involved in socio-civic activities with its yearly contributions to the Catholic 19 Social Service, since the year of 2007. Mr. Mercado helped the Filipino Community 20of Guam to raise funds for the disaster relief of the Typhoon Ketsana (Ondoy) 21 calamity. He took part in other inter-association activities, encouraging individual and 22 group support to help vulnerable members of the Association, especially during their hospitalization and bereavement. The love and devotion Mr. Mercado, along with his 23 24 wife, Mrs. Aurora M. Mercado, and family have for St. Peter are reflected through the 25 many accomplishments that Mr. Ignacio L. Mercado has made while serving in his 26 position as President of the Apalit Association of Guam; now therefore, be it
