3           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Joey R. Paulino of *Malojloj* is the son of the late Jose Meno  
4 Paulino and Teresita Meno Paulino; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Joey R. Paulino is married to Doris Cruz Paulino, formerly of  
6 *Asan*, and their children are Brent, Valerie and Tammy Paulino; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Joey R. Paulino is a product of Guam’s public school system  
2 having attended *Inarajan* Elementary School and *Inarajan* Junior High School; and he  
3 graduated in 1978 from George Washington High School; and

4           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Joey R. Paulino’s post-secondary education was attained at  
5 the University of Guam, where he graduated *cum laude* with a Bachelor’s degree in  
6 Political Science, in 1983; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Joey R. Paulino, who currently also holds a Master Educator  
8 Certification, taught high school social studies at George Washington High School  
9 and *Inarajan* High School for thirteen years; and he taught middle school social  
10 studies at Untalan Middle School in the spring of 1984, and taught at *Inarajan* Middle  
11 School for seventeen years; and

12           **WHEREAS**, besides teaching during the regular school year, Mr. Joey R.  
13 Paulino also taught summer school at George Washington High School, *Inarajan*  
14 High School, John F. Kennedy High School, Southern High School, and *Inarajan*  
15 Middle School, where he also served as the Summer School Coordinator for three  
16 years; and

17           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Joey R. Paulino’s commitment and dedication to his students  
18 extended beyond the classroom to extracurricular activities having served as Close Up  
19 Program Advisor, Future Educators of America Advisor, 8th Grade Club Advisor,  
20 Junior Varsity Volleyball Team Coach, and Mock Trial Team Coach; and

21           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Joey R. Paulino had also assumed faculty leadership roles  
22 during his many years as a teacher having served as a Middle School Team Leader for  
23 sixteen years; as the Team Chair for the *Inarajan* Middle School Accreditation Self-  
24 Study; as the Department Chair at *Inarajan* High School for six years; and as the  
25 Union Steward at *Inarajan* Middle School for nine years; now therefore, be it
