3 **WHEREAS,** Salon Paradis is a renowned business on Guam that first began as  
4 a business concept by Carina Fejerang, who had received the Grand Prize at the first  
5 Shell Live Wire Business Plan Competition in 2002; and after careful planning, the  
6 Salon Paradis was established in July 2004. Mrs. Fejerang's success is rooted in the

1 support of her family, as her husband Jerome, and their daughter, Paradis Jolie  
2 Fejerang, continue to stand beside her as she works to ensure that her business thrives  
3 through Guam's changing times; and

4         **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Fejerang's journey to success began with her educational  
5 pursuits. In 1996, she received a Cosmetology Degree from Clover Park Technical  
6 College, in Washington State; and she then received a certification in Aromatherapy.  
7 In the same year, she became a Sebastian Advocate; and she then was later offered an  
8 opportunity to become a Sebastian Educator for Salon Services Incorporated in 1998.  
9 In 2001, the Fejerang family moved to Guam and Mrs. Fejerang made her mark in the  
10 industry as an award winning Cosmetologist at Creative Hair Design, Progressive  
11 Design, Men's Hair Sculpture, Women's Hair Sculpture, and Evening Make Up.  
12 Throughout the years, she has trained and educated many Cosmetologists in  
13 Washington State and on Guam. She has earned the title of: Master of Creative Hair  
14 Design. Today, she devotes her love of the industry to her Salon Paradis Team by  
15 providing education, mentorship, and guidance; and

16         **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Fejerang is known for opening the island's first Day Spa, as  
17 Salon Paradis offers exceptional services to the people of Guam by providing  
18 innovative packages and full on services; and it continues to revolutionize the beauty  
19 industry on Guam by transcending cosmetology into a professional work of art; and

20         **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Fejerang continues to be a role model for the women of  
21 Guam. She is a mentor to those who know her, and is an advocate for all women who  
22 aspire to be business owners. She has shared her success with others through her  
23 involvement with numerous civic and charitable efforts, and her invaluable  
24 contributions; and

25         **WHEREAS**, in 2006, Carina began the reformation of one of the island's first  
26 civic organizations, known as the Guam Women's First Club (GWC). She assisted in

1 researching and analyzing twenty (20) years of the GWC’s treasury accounts, which  
2 included a comparative analysis of the organization’s expenditures, scholarship  
3 payments, and donations. She reformed GWC’s accounting practices and received the  
4 first GWC “President’s Award” for her outstanding work, and her service as a  
5 Treasurer; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Carina’s civic involvement includes the planning and chairing of  
7 various events for non-profit organizations; as well as creating new events such as: the  
8 Women of Movement (honoring the movers and shakers of our island); the U’zeum’s  
9 Fairy Tale Ball (the first islandwide children’s ball); the Unconditional Love’s Walk  
10 your Dog 5K event (the first fun run for dogs and families); and she also coordinated  
11 the first ISLAND WALK OUT and STAND AGAINST VIOLENCE; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Carina continues to offer her guidance and expertise to several  
13 organizations so that they may successfully establish their non-profit organizations by  
14 assisting them through non-profit filing, strategic planning, and organization structure  
15 development. Currently, she advocates against violence and for the rights of victims  
16 through a movement called, Random Women’s Rally “RaWR!”; and she has taken the  
17 lead in re-establishing the Guam Family Justice Center (One Stop Victims Center);  
18 and

19 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Fejerang’s notable business speaks to her ability to be part  
20 of numerous civic efforts. In the business community, she is known and respected as a  
21 role model for the women of Guam; now therefore, be it

23 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend Mrs. Carina Fejerang,

3 for all Guamanians; and be it further


4 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
