- WHEREAS, through the leadership and vision of Mrs. Cecilia A.Q. Morrison,
- 4 former Deputy Director of the Bureau of Women's Affairs, the AmeriCorps program was

launched on Guam in June 1995 through the Office of the Governor, Federal Programs

2 Office; and

WHEREAS, the initial funding of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) from the Corporation for National and Community Service supported the work of forty-four (44) full-time and part-time members in both government and non-government entities, including, the Catholic Social Service; the Department of Parks and Recreation; *Inafa'maolek*, Inc.; Sanctuary, Inc.; and the University of Guam's College of Agriculture and Life Sciences; and

WHEREAS, in 1998, the AmeriCorps program on Guam was restructured and centrally administered by the Governor's Community Outreach, Federal Programs Office, with volunteers recruited at three (3) placement sites, including, the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Department of Youth Affairs, and the Guam Public Library System. Through Executive Order No. 2005-22, the Governor's Serve Guam Commission was established to oversee, administer and manage the AmeriCorps programs under the purview of the Office of the Governor of Guam; and

WHEREAS, AmeriCorps programs across the United States engage more than seventy-five thousand (75,000) Americans in intensive service each year at nonprofits, schools, public agencies, and community and faith-based groups. Since 1994, more than nine hundred thousand (900,000) AmeriCorps members have contributed more than 1.2 billion hours in service across the country, while tackling pressing problems and mobilizing millions of volunteers for the organizations they serve; and

WHEREAS, since 2005, the Governor's Serve Guam Commission-Guam AmeriCorps has received more than 14 Million Dollars from the Corporation for National and Community Service to support the creation of jobs and to provide meaningful pathways to opportunities for Guam's young adults entering the workforce. This significant investment has helped more than one thousand five hundred (1,500) young adults to learn valuable work skills, earn money for education, and develop an appreciation for their citizenship; now therefore, be it
