1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***

3           **WHEREAS,** Agrenilda Antolin has completed thirty (30) years of government  
4 of Guam service as a Psychiatric Nurse III at the Guam Behavioral Health and

1 Wellness Center, which was formerly known as the Department of Mental Health and  
2 Substance Abuse; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in 1979, Ms. Antolin graduated from Arellano University in  
4 Manila, Philippines, where she earned a Bachelor's Degree in Science as a nursing  
5 student ; and

6 **WHEREAS**, prior to her government of Guam career, Ms. Antolin had worked  
7 as a cashier for Payless Supermarket; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 1986, Ms. Antolin began her career with the government of  
9 Guam serving as a Psychiatric Technician at the Department of Mental Health and  
10 Substance, which is now called the Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center;  
11 and

12 **WHEREAS**, in April 1986, Ms. Antolin passed her National Council of  
13 Licensure Examination for Licensed Practical Nurses, and worked as a Licensed  
14 Practical Nurse I; and in July 1991, she passed her National Council of Licensure  
15 Examination for Registered Nurses, and worked as a Psychiatric Nurse I; and

16 **WHEREAS**, through her satisfactory performance in the workforce, Ms.  
17 Antolin was promoted to a Psychiatric Nurse II, and then promoted to Psychiatric  
18 Nurse III; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in March 2014, Ms. Antolin was appointed to serve as an Acting  
20 Nursing Administrator for the Nursing Division; and

21 **WHEREAS**, during her thirty (30) years of government of Guam service, Ms.  
22 Antolin has been involved in various job duties, to include working in the Adult In-  
23 Patient and Children In-Patient Sections, as an Outpatient Nurse in the Medication  
24 Clinic, and as a Psychiatric Community Nurse; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Antolin also served in numerous policy and procedure  
26 committees for the strategic planning for behavioral health infrastructure, reflecting

1 the industry's best practices and standards; she was involved with CARF  
2 Accreditation, and attended multidisciplinary treatment team meetings; and she was  
3 an active member in consult team meetings, and served as a mentor for nursing  
4 students attending the University of Guam and Guam Community College; and

5 **WHEREAS**, as a long-time Psychiatric Nurse, Ms. Antolin is to be recognized  
6 for her outstanding work at the Department. She will be missed for her invaluable and  
7 institutional knowledge, and her contributions to the Agency; and her success and  
8 professionalism is greatly appreciated by her colleagues; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam also wish to express a sincere *Un Dangkolo*  
10 *Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase'* to Agrenilda's husband, Amador C. Antolin, and her children,  
11 Steven M. Antolin, Vanessa Antolin, and daughter in law, Kathryn Devis Antolin for  
12 their support and dedication to helping in Ms. Antolin's noble career; and

13 **WHEREAS**, as Ms. Antolin enters the ranks of the retired class, she will not be  
14 fully retired, as she will be more actively involved with her church (the Charismatic  
15 Group at Our Lady of Lourdes), traveling to visit her children, becoming a loving and  
16 supportive grandmother, and working with her business; now therefore, be it
