1           **WHEREAS**, the week of September 15 through September 19, 2014, has been  
2 proclaimed nationally and on Guam, as “Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve  
3 Week”; and

4           **WHEREAS**, the anniversary of the 9/11 attacks in New York and the Pentagon  
5 reminds us that hundreds of thousands of our fellow citizen-service members continue  
6 to serve and maintain a constant vigilance in order to protect our freedoms and the  
7 American way of life; and

8           **WHEREAS**, standing tall among these troops are our nation’s National Guard  
9 and Reserve forces, which continue to serve our island and country with distinction.  
10 Our National Guardsmen and women, and our Reservists, continue to serve on active  
11 duty on every front of the Global War on Terror; and

12           **WHEREAS**, almost half of our military force resides in the Reserve  
13 Components, which is comprised of the National Guard and Reserve; and

14           **WHEREAS**, the organization, the Guam-CNMI Committee for Employer  
15 Support of the Guard and Reserve, through its volunteers and employers, support this  
16 effort and provide a degree of comfort for service members of the National Guard and  
17 Reserve so that they can focus on their military mission without worrying about their  
18 civilian jobs at home; and

19           **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam are grateful to many local employers for their  
20 support of the Guard and Reserve service members, and their families. Together, our  
21 National Guard and Reserve forces, and their employers, are united in purpose and  
22 reflect the highest standards of professionalism and honor; and

23           **WHEREAS**, some of ESGR’s goals are to gain and maintain support from the  
24 employers of Guard and Reserve service members; to educate customers and  
25 stakeholders; and to continue to refine the ESGR organization for relevancy,  
26 effectiveness and efficiency; now therefore, be it
