1BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I2MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

1 WHEREAS, drug and alcohol abuse has devastating consequences on the 2 community at large, most especially on families and youth who have endured first-3 hand the harmful effects of this widespread epidemic. As an island community, we 4 value the health and safety of our residents, especially Guam's youth. Today, we face 5 many challenges as we try to protect our loved ones from the ongoing battle against 6 substance abuse; and

WHEREAS, substance abuse either through the use of drugs or alcohol, not
only has a negative effect on individuals, families, businesses and schools, but it is
also a contributing factor in the three (3) leading causes of death among adolescents,
which are accidents, homicides, and suicides; and

WHEREAS, the "Red Ribbon Campaign" began in 1985 after drug traffickers in Mexico City murdered Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) agent Enrique "Kiki" Camarena. His friends and neighbors wore red badges of satin signifying their utmost respect and admiration for his courage, determination, and his honorable and ultimate sacrifice; and to show that they would continue to take up his fight against illegal drug activities. The mission of the "Red Ribbon Campaign" is to present a unified and visible commitment towards the creation of a "Drug-Free America"; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the seriousness of this threat, the National Family Partnership initiated the first "Red Ribbon Campaign" in 1986. This grassroots effort emphasized education and the importance of teaching children, teenagers, families, and communities about the dangers of drug and alcohol abuse. It is now the oldest and largest drug prevention program that reaches millions of youth, families and communities in every corner of the country. Significant progress has been made in reducing drug and alcohol abuse among young adults; and

WHEREAS, Guam's participation in this national effort was started in 1988 by
 the *Dededo* Drug-Free Organization (now known as Youth for Youth LIVE! Guam).

The 2014 "Red Ribbon Campaign" Committee is comprised of representatives from
 federal and local government agencies: the military; non-profit organizations; and the
 Guam Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, the 2014 "Red Ribbon Campaign" theme is: "Love Yourself. Be
Drug Free!" and some of this year's activities include: an essay contest; a school
gate/wall decorating contest; a Red Ribbon Wave in *Hagåtña*; a community outreach
at the Micronesia Mall; a "Say Boo to Drugs" community event; school presentations;
and numerous print, television, and radio media events; and

9 WHEREAS, education, prevention and outreach activities are critical weapons 10 in the community's effort to fight substance abuse. It is the goal of the "Red Ribbon 11 Campaign" Committee to involve families, schools, businesses, churches, law 12 enforcement agencies and service organizations to establish an atmosphere that 13 supports awareness and education that will help to prevent illegal drug related 14 activities; and

WHEREAS, on the occasion of the 2014 "Red Ribbon Month," *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* encourages all the residents of Guam to consider ways to participate in this important effort. As we build upon the successes of the past, we strengthen the Guam of tomorrow; and with strong resolve and creative leadership, we must strive to protect our community from the preventable dangers of alcohol, tobacco, and drug abuse; and

WHEREAS, these "Red Ribbon Campaign" activities are being made possible by the "Red Ribbon Campaign" Committee. The ongoing awareness efforts will concentrate on promoting healthy choices and lifestyles that are drug, alcohol, and violence-free; now therefore, be it
