2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***
3 **WHEREAS,** the Western Pacific Regional Veterans Community Living Center
4 (WPRVCLC) is a project that is spearheaded by Veterans and other community

1 stakeholders who desire to improve Veterans' access to medical care, treatment, and
2 facilities to address the specific needs of Veterans residing on Guam and the Western
3 Pacific Region. This project will be the first Veterans based facility on Guam that will
4 be inclusive of all Veterans services; and

5 **WHEREAS**, with great hopes to garner the VA's support for this project, the
6 WPRVCLC is anticipated to restore faith in the VA's ability to serve the needs of
7 Veterans who reside in the Western Pacific Region by consolidating all the VA
8 agencies into one location, which will be based in a community setting; as well as,
9 providing transportation for Veterans and their dependents from their homes to the
10 Center; providing home-based primary care; providing services to treat various
11 medical conditions of Veterans and ensure the continuity of quality of care for
12 Veterans; providing transitional services for service members returning from
13 deployment; and providing short-term and long-term stay at the Center for Veterans
14 who are in need of continuous specialized care. This Center will help alleviate the
15 need for Veterans to travel to VA clinics in the U.S. mainland; and


16 **WHEREAS**, the WPRVCLC is anticipated to assist our Veterans with
17 employment through the VA Compensated Work Therapy Program; additionally, the
18 development of this project is also anticipated to create employment for the people of
19 Guam before, during and after the construction of the Center; and

20 **WHEREAS**, this Center will also serve as a symbol of gratitude that our island
21 community has for the Veterans of Guam, the Federated States of Micronesia, the
22 Marshall Islands, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Palau, and the
23 Philippines. The service of all of these Veterans will always be remembered, and
24 support and services ought to be duly afforded to our Veterans for their service and
25 sacrifice for the people of Guam, the Western Pacific region, and the nation; now
26 therefore, be it

2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
