3 **WHEREAS, Ms. Therese “Rese” Cruz Aguon, Word Processing Secretary II,**
4 **Bureau of Statistics and Plans (Bureau of Planning), retires on September 26, 2014,**
5 **after completing thirty (30) years of government of Guam service; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Aguon graduated in 1982 from the Guam Community
2 College - Vocational Technical High School, where she took clerical courses; and she
3 then started working for Mobil Oil, Guam, in January 1983; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in November 1984, Ms. Aguon began her career with the
5 government of Guam, working as a Clerk Typist I at the Department of Corrections;
6 and

7 **WHEREAS**, in August 1986, Ms. Aguon was promoted to Secretary I with the
8 Guam Coastal Management Program (GCMP), Bureau of Planning; and on August
9 27, 1990, through her outstanding performance of job tasks and the merit system, she
10 was promoted to Word Processing Secretary II; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Aguon has served under eight (8) Executive Branch
12 Administrations, with three (3) Governors serving two (2) consecutive four (4) year
13 terms. She has served under nine (9) directors, and she was working at the agency
14 during the time of the merger of the Department of Commerce and the Guam Health
15 Planning Division, and the name change to the Bureau of Statistics and Plans; and

16 **WHEREAS**, throughout her thirty (30) years of government service, Ms.
17 Aguon has attended numerous trainings, workshops, seminars, conferences and
18 meetings, including: records management officer courses; community first aid and
19 safety classes; Office Procedures III; Pacific Islands Training Initiative (PITI)
20 Training Programs; the Governor's 1991 Clerical/Secretarial Seminar; Software
21 Training on WordPerfect; Effective Writing for Secretaries; the Annual Relay for
22 Life; the Annual Government of Guam Labor Day Picnic; and the Annual Halloween
23 for Children, to name a few, where she represented the Bureau; and she has received
24 other recognitions for her professionalism and her outstanding performance of job
25 tasks and duties; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in Ms. Aguon’s thirty (30) years of government service as an
2 experienced word processing secretary, her perspective on the in-depth understanding
3 of the government administrative and clerical processes, and the mission and
4 objectives of the Bureau of Statistics and Plans, has led to the smooth, effective and
5 efficient operation of the government agency she has been a part of for over thirty (30)
6 years; and

7 **WHEREAS**, as a long-time staff member of the Bureau of Statistics and Plans,
8 Ms. Aguon is to be recognized for her outstanding work for the Bureau; and she will
9 be missed for her invaluable and institutional knowledge, and her contributions to
10 Guam’s social, physical, economic and environmental development; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Aguon has exceeded the expectations for the role she plays in
12 the Bureau, and was proudly nominated as the Bureau of Statistics and Plans’
13 Employee of the Year under the Clerical and Secretarial Category for the MagPro
14 Awards in 2013; now therefore, be it

16 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
