1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2           ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Rodolfo O. Carino has dedicated over thirty-three (33) years  
4 of service to the government of Guam, while working at the Judiciary of Guam. He  
5 will be celebrating his retirement with his wife, Evangeline; and their children,  
6 Richard, Randolph and Roselyn; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Rodolfo started his government of Guam career at the Judiciary  
8 of Guam in 1981, and he understands hard work. He has gained invaluable work  
9 experience while serving in administration and in law enforcement at the Judiciary.

1 He has contributed to our island community by upholding the peace and protection of  
2 the people of Guam as a law enforcement official. In his retiring role as an Alternative  
3 Sentencing Supervisor, Rodolfo has successfully led the Alternative Sentencing Office  
4 (ASO), which is a section within the Probation Services Division at the Judiciary, by  
5 carrying out the ASO's program initiatives of educating offenders on the  
6 consequences of their actions so they can learn to take responsibility for their criminal  
7 acts; by providing judges, government attorneys, and defense counsels with workable  
8 alternatives to traditional sentencing options; and by helping offenders better  
9 themselves so they can become contributing members of our community; and

10 **WHEREAS**, as a committed member of the Judiciary, Mr. Carino has actively  
11 participated in many judiciary events; and he was awarded with a Commendation for  
12 his participation in the grand opening of the Judicial Center in 1991. He further  
13 supported the efforts to secure the role of the Supreme Court and the Judicial Branch  
14 as a separate, coequal and independent branch by the Congressional enactment of  
15 federal law, also known as the Judicial Empowerment Act, by continuously providing  
16 exceptional service during the evolution of our island's judiciary; and

17 **WHEREAS**, throughout his career, Mr. Carino has garnered respect from his  
18 colleagues and peers, as he has received Outstanding Performance Awards given by  
19 the Judiciary of Guam for employees who go above and beyond the call of duty  
20 during the course of their work. He has also been a positive role model amongst his  
21 colleagues, as he has always encouraged his colleagues to perform their duties in a  
22 professional and exceptional manner; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Rodolfo's service to the people of Guam also extends outside of  
24 his employment at the Judiciary. He has engaged himself in community services such  
25 as island beautification projects throughout the villages and at our schools; now


