4 **and she is the youngest of twelve (12) siblings. With the desire to make a positive**  
5 **impact and improve the lives of all children, Mrs. Paz Padua enrolled and graduated**

1 from Far Eastern University in 1972, where she earned a Bachelor of Science Degree  
2 in Elementary Education. Immediately after graduation, Mrs. Paz Padua moved to  
3 Okinawa, Japan, and became a teacher at Christ the King International School. It was  
4 here where she met her future husband, Mr. Ramon B. Padua, who was a Civil  
5 Engineer at Kadena Air Base; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Paz Padua married Mr. Ramon B. Padua in February 1973;  
7 and they have two (2) sons, Omar and Allen. Throughout her thirty-nine (39) years of  
8 marriage and raising a family, Mrs. Paz Padua continued to invest in her education,  
9 and she earned a Master of Arts degree in Curriculum & Instruction from Michigan  
10 State University in 1982. She has always felt honored by the opportunity to play such  
11 an important role in the lives of all her students; and

13 visa and she moved to Guam. She immediately began teaching at St. Francis School
