3           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Gayle R. Osborn is the daughter of Avery Osborn Jr. and  
4 Josefa Francisco Osborn; and she is the mother of Avery Ramos, Neil Ramos, and  
5 Athena R. Duenas; and is also blessed with eleven (11) grandchildren; and

1           **WHEREAS**, in 1981, Gayle started working as a private secretary at the  
2 former Department of Mental Health & Substance Abuse (DMHSA), which is now  
3 known as the Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center (GBHWC); and

4           **WHEREAS**, in 1983, Gayle worked as a Program Coordinator II within the  
5 Planning Division of the DMHSA; and shortly thereafter, she moved to the  
6 Prevention and Training Branch as a Program Coordinator II; and

7           **WHEREAS**, throughout Gayle Osborn’s thirty-three (33) years of public  
8 service, she has touched the lives of a countless number of people in the Guam  
9 community, and in the neighboring Micronesian islands; and

10           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Osborn is an indispensable member of the GBHWC  
11 Prevention and Training Branch; and she brings with her many years of wisdom,  
12 experience and insight to the team; and

13           **WHEREAS**, Gayle is also valued by the GBHWC Prevention and Training  
14 Branch team for the humor, laughter, and confidence she emanates when  
15 overcoming the many challenges faced by the team; and

16           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Osborn is the co-founder, lead advisor, mentor, and lead  
17 program coordinator of the formidable youth leadership program on Guam, known  
18 as Youth for Youth Live! Guam, formerly known as the *Dededo* Drug-Free  
19 Organization, which spans a period of over twenty-five (25) years, where Guam’s  
20 youth are trained as trainers and leaders in substance abuse prevention and suicide  
21 prevention impacting over one thousand five hundred (1,500) trained youth  
22 leaders, and reaching over thirteen thousand (13,000) elementary, middle and high  
23 school students; and where she is known by several generations of youth as “*Mama*  
24 *Gayle*”; and

1           **WHEREAS**, for the past twenty-four (24) years, Gayle Osborn has led and  
2 co-led several annual signature events, such as the Annual Youth Summer  
3 Swimming and Water Safety Program, and the Annual Youth for Youth  
4 Conference; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Gayle is a Certified Prevention Specialist, and she has been  
6 involved in the early establishment of drug-free workplace programs in both the  
7 government and private sectors; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Gayle was a trainer in topics, such as, Stress and Anger  
9 Management; Suicide Prevention/Intervention; Alcohol Abuse Intervention  
10 Training for Supervisors; Crisis Intervention; and Youth Coalition Building; and

11           **WHEREAS**, Gayle is a trainer in the Gathering of Native Americans  
12 Curriculum applied on Guam, as the Gathering of Pacific Islanders for PEACE  
13 (GOPEACE); and

14           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Osborn's professional memberships and affiliations  
15 includes her involvement in the National Prevention Network, which strives to  
16 guide and lead national, state, regional, and local prevention efforts in reducing the  
17 incidents and prevalence of alcohol, tobacco, and other drug problems; and

18           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Osborn's other professional affiliations include the  
19 National Asian Pacific American Families Against Substance Abuse  
20 (NAPAFASA); the Asian Pacific Partners for Empowerment and Leadership  
21 (APPEAL); and the Youth to Youth International; and

22           **WHEREAS**, throughout her career, Gayle has achieved additional skills and  
23 trainings, such as being a Facilitator for the Fresh Start Smoking Cessation  
24 program, and the Beginning Alcohol Basic Education Studies (BABES) program  
25 for K-3<sup>rd</sup> grade; the Substance Abuse Prevention Specialist Training Course with

1 the National Interagency Civil-Military Institute/West CAPT.; the Applied Suicide  
2 Intervention Skills Training (ASIST); the safeTalk Training; the Brief Tobacco  
3 Intervention Training, and training youth inspectors/enforcement  
4 officers/chaperones on tobacco vendor monitoring and surveillance protocols; and  
5 the Kids Under Twenty-One - Suicide Intervention Training; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Osborn has always placed the community of youths'  
7 needs first and foremost, and she has always seen the fruit of her labor as heartfelt  
8 reward in itself; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Osborn, as a long-time staff member of the GBHWC and  
10 an advocate of numerous community programs, will be recognized for her  
11 exemplary dedication and work in those organizations; and she will be missed for  
12 the institutional knowledge that has made her an invaluable asset who has been  
13 able to meaningfully and positively impact the many generations of youth on  
14 Guam and Micronesia; now therefore, be it
