3           **WHEREAS,** Peter M. Tydingco is the son of Juan and Rosa Pangelinan  
4 Tydingco; and he has four (4) children: Melissa, Peter, Amanda and Sonia Tydingco,  
5 who all live abroad; and

6           **WHEREAS,** Peter M. Tydingco had served in the United States Marine Corps  
7 for twenty-two (22) years; and he retired at the rank of Sergeant Major; and

1           **WHEREAS**, in November 1993, Peter M. Tydingco started his government of  
2 Guam career working as a Police Officer I with the Guam Police Department; and he  
3 was then promoted to the position of Police Officer II in August 1995; and

4           **WHEREAS**, ten (10) years later, in February 2005, Peter M. Tydingco was  
5 promoted to the position of Police Officer III; and

6           **WHEREAS**, on September 20, 2014, Peter M. Tydingco officially retired from  
7 the Guam Police Department as a Police Officer III, after twenty-one (21) years of  
8 government of Guam service; and

9           **WHEREAS**, during his career with the Guam Police Department, Peter M.  
10 Tydingco was recognized with a commendation in July of 1994; and he was also  
11 recognized and commended for his efforts and support in the aftermath of Typhoon  
12 Dale. In May of 2003, he was awarded with the Distinguished Service Award; and

13           **WHEREAS**, after his retirement, Peter M. Tydingco hopes to pursue his  
14 passion for electronics and woodworking by furthering his education in those fields;

23 the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Peter M.


