3 **WHEREAS**, Gertrudes C. Champaco is from the village of *Merizo*; and she
4 is the daughter of †Jose and †Carmen Champaco; and has twelve (12) siblings - four
5 (4) brothers and eight (8) sisters; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in June of 1985, Gertrudes C. Champaco started her
7 government of Guam career working as a Clerk Typist at the Guam Police
8 Department. She then took on the position of Secretary I (Typist) in June of 1991;
9 and in February 1998, she moved up to the position of Secretary II (Typist); and

1 **WHEREAS**, fifteen (15) years later, in October of 2013, Gertrudes C.
2 Champaco took on the position of Administrative Secretary II, where she remained
3 until her retirement in September 2014; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Gertrudes C. Champaco had received numerous Letters of
5 Appreciation, to include: Dedication and Loyalty (June 1985), and Labor Day
6 Festivities (September 1994); and she was awarded with a Certificate of
7 Appreciation (November 2008); and

8 **WHEREAS**, Gertrudes C. Champaco also received numerous
9 commendations, such as: Typhoon Paka Commendation (January 1998);
10 Commendation Award (October 2001); Commendation Award (May 2009); and
11 Commendation Award (May 2011); and

12 **WHEREAS**, Gertrudes C. Champaco was awarded with the Service Award
13 (October 1993); an award for Demonstrative Support for the Annual Easter Picnic
14 (April 1996); the Civilian of the Year award (May 1999); a Letter of
15 Congratulations for Employee of the Year (November 1999); the Distinguished
16 Service Medal award (May 2000); and a Certificate of Appreciation (November
17 2008); and

18 **WHEREAS**, after her retirement, Gertrudes C. Champaco plans to travel and
19 visit with family during the holidays; and to enjoy her retirement and her life each
20 day; now therefore, be it
