3 **WHEREAS**, Ricardo M. Leon Guerrero was born and raised in the village of
4 *Barrigada*; and he is married to Janet Leon Guerrero, his wife of thirty-five (35)
5 years; and together they have four (4) children: Martha, Ricardo, Janalyn and
6 Janessa (twins); a son-in-law, Patrick, and a daughter-in-law, Valerie. They are also
7 blessed with twelve (12) grandchildren; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in June of 1978, Major Ricardo M. Leon Guerrero started his
9 government of Guam career working as a Police Officer I with the Guam Police

1 Department. He was then promoted to Police Sergeant I in May of 1984. Four
2 years later, in January of 1990, he was promoted to Police Sergeant II. Major Leon
3 Guerrero was promoted again in August of 1991 to Police Lieutenant; and then to
4 Police Captain in January of 1997; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Major Ricardo M. Leon Guerrero was promoted to Police
6 Major in September of 2007; and he maintained this rank until September 2014,
7 when he concludes his career in the Guam Police Department after thirty-six (36)
8 years of government of Guam service; and

9 **WHEREAS**, in his military occupation, Sergeant Major Ricardo M. Leon
10 Guerrero joined the Guam Army National Guard on June 10, 1982. Sergeant Major
11 Ricardo M. Leon Guerrero was recognized in June of 2007 with Legislative
12 Resolution No. 100 from the 29th Guam Legislature on his retirement from the
13 Guam Army National Guard; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Major Ricardo M. Leon Guerrero's civilian education includes:
15 a Baccalaureate Degree in Criminal Justice Administration from the University of
16 Guam; the Guam Police Academy; the FBI First Line Supervisor Course; a graduate
17 of the Asia Security Studies, and the Comprehensive Security Response to
18 Terrorism; and the Executive Course at the Asia Pacific Center of Security Studies,
19 Fort DeRussy, Hawaii. His military education includes: Basic Non-Commission
20 Officers Course; Advance Non-Commission Course; Instructor Training Course;
21 First Sergeant Course; and the Sergeant Majors Course; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Major Ricardo M. Leon Guerrero currently holds the rank of
23 Police Major with the Guam Police Department; and has overseen the
24 Neighborhood Patrol Division, the Criminal Investigation Division, the Guam
25 Highway Patrol Division, the Forensic Science Division, and the Special Operations

1 Command, which includes the SWAT Unit, and the Governor's Security Unit. He
2 was also designated as the Guam Police Department's Incident Commander; and he
3 manages the Police Department's resources during emergency crises; and

4 **WHEREAS**, throughout his career, Major Ricardo M. Leon Guerrero has
5 been recognized with numerous commendations, to include: a Commendatory Letter
6 (June 1979 and May 1989); a Professionalism award (August 1980); a U.S.
7 Department of Justice/INS commendation (February 1982); a Suppression Teams
8 award [A & B] NPC (May 1986); and an Outstanding Performance award
9 (December 1993); and

10 **WHEREAS**, Major Ricardo M. Leon was also recognized for his dedicated
11 service with numerous awards, such as: the Commanding Officer's Citation Award
12 (March 1982); a Unit Commendation as Neighborhood Patrol Commander
13 (December 1986); and a Unit Citation for Excellence in Juvenile Investigations
14 (May 1992); and

15 **WHEREAS**, Major Ricardo M. Leon Guerrero has also received numerous
16 Letters of Appreciation, to include: Logistics/Police Week Committee (May 1990);
17 Bishop Baumgartner Middle School (January 1994); Micronesian Games (May
18 1994); Bud Int'l K.K. Tokyo, Japan (June 1994); and Constant
19 Dedication/Leadership (December 1996); now therefore, be it


20 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
