3 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Anita Borja Enriquez has been appointed to serve as the
4 Senior Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs at the University of Guam;
5 and

6 **WHEREAS**, as Senior Vice President, Dr. Enriquez oversees the College of
7 Liberal Arts and Social Sciences; the College of Natural and Applied Sciences; the
8 School of Nursing and Health Sciences; the School of Education; the School of

1 Business and Public Administration; Enrollment Management and Student Services;
2 Learning Resources; the Computer Center; the Center of Excellence for
3 Developmental Disabilities Education Research and Service; as well as Sponsored
4 Programs and Research; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez is the University’s liaison to the Western
6 Association of Schools and Colleges, the regional accrediting body; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez, a former Dean of the School of Business and Public
8 Administration, a corporate planning and development manager, and a management
9 consultant, established her first business at the age of nineteen (19). She secured over
10 One Million Dollars in technical assistance grants from the U.S. Department of
11 Commerce, Economic Development Administration to establish the UOG Pacific
12 Center for Economic Initiatives. She has also written and secured numerous grants, to
13 include the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration -
14 Investment Award for the “Guam Enterprise Initiative – OVOP,” awarded in 2013
15 (\$190,000); the Buy Local Guam Campaign funded by the U.S. Department of
16 Interior Office of Insular Affairs, awarded in 2011 (\$150,000); the establishment of
17 the Guam Veterans Business Outreach Center by the U.S. Small Business
18 Administration, awarded in 2010 (\$150,000); the establishment of the Guam
19 Procurement Technical Assistance Center funded by the Defense Logistics Agency,
20 awarded in 2008, 2009 and 2010 (\$289,476, \$264,096 and \$263,028); the U.S.
21 Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration - Technical
22 Assistance Award for the “*Hagåtña* Revitalization Plan,” awarded in 2008
23 (\$200,000); and many other grants that have benefitted the island of Guam; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez also serves the island in many capacities, to include
25 being the founding Vice President of the Guam Women’s Chamber of Commerce
26 Board of Directors; the Vice President of the Guampedia Foundation, Inc. Board of

1 Directors; and the Director of Foundations for the Rotary Club of *Tumon* Bay Board
2 of Directors. She also serves on the Pacific Islands Small Business Development
3 Center Advisory Board, the Guam-Micronesia Mission Education Board, the Guam
4 Visitors Bureau’s Administrative and Legislative Affairs Committee, and the Guam
5 Procurement Advisory Council; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez holds professional memberships with the
7 International Economic Development Council, the U.S. Women’s Chamber of
8 Commerce, and the California Association of Local Economic Developers. She has
9 served on the Junior Achievement Board of Directors, the Guam Chamber of
10 Commerce Small Business Focus and Development Committee, and was the founding
11 Vice President of Guam Marketing Association; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez won the U.S. Small Business Administration 2013
13 “Women in Business Champion of the Year” Award; the 2012 University of Guam
14 “Administrator of the Year” Award; the 2011 Guam Community College “Alumna of
15 the Year” Award; and the Academy of Economics and Economic Education
16 “Distinguished Research Award”; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez earned a D.B.A. degree in International Business-
18 Marketing from U.S.I.U. (Alliant International University); an M.B.A. degree from
19 the University of Guam, a B.S. in Management and Associates degree in Computer
20 Studies from the University of Maryland; and a certificate from the Institute for
21 Management and Leadership in Education at the Harvard Graduate School of
22 Education; now therefore, be it
