1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Mr. John L. Wusstig has dedicated thirty-one (31) years of
4 service to the government of Guam while working at the Guam Fire Department. He
5 will now be celebrating his well-deserved retirement with his wife, Marie; and their
6 children: Ian, Mara, and Walter; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Chief John Wusstig began his government of Guam career on
2 March 26, 1984; and he has worked his way up the ranks within the various divisions
3 of the Guam Fire Department (GFD). He has performed important tasks while
4 working in the GFD Prevention Bureau, in which he was responsible for the
5 enforcement of fire laws and regulations; and conducted the fire inspections and
6 abatement of existing and potential fire hazards. He continued on to work at other
7 duties and served with the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Bureau, where he
8 assisted with the administration of the EMS and Rescue Operations, along with the
9 development of the EMS Division’s goals and objectives. He was also responsible for
10 overseeing the programs and services relative to the suppression and extinguishment
11 of all the fire incidents on Guam; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in March of 1997, Chief Wusstig attained the rank of Battalion
13 Fire Chief, and he planned, organized, and directed the operations, training and
14 maintenance of fire companies and medic units on assigned platoons. Additionally, he
15 had been appointed to oversee the Suppression, and the EMS and Rescue Divisions;
16 and

17 **WHEREAS**, while serving as the Acting Fire Chief from September 2006 to
18 January 2007, and as recently as January 2013 to February 2014, Chief Wusstig has
19 led the agency in planning, coordinating, and evaluating the Fire and EMS operations.
20 He established policies and procedures for the Fire and EMS Departments in order to
21 implement directives to better carry out policies and goals, including those set forth in
22 their Affirmative Action Plan; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Chief Wusstig currently serves on the “Western Pacific Islands
24 Association of Fire Chiefs” as a member of the Board of Directors. He is also a
25 member of the “Guam Seismic Advisory Committee” of the Guam Homeland
26 Security; the President of the George Washington High School PTSA (Parent Teacher

1 Student Association); and serves as a member of the American Cancer Society's
2 Relay for Life committee; now therefore, be it

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
4 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
5 of Guam, congratulate and commend Mr. John L. Wusstig on his retirement from the
6 Guam Fire Department; and does further extend a heartfelt appreciation and *Un*
7 *Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to him for his outstanding service to the people of
8 Guam; and be it further
