WHEREAS, Chief John Wusstig began his government of Guam career on March 26, 1984; and he has worked his way up the ranks within the various divisions of the Guam Fire Department (GFD). He has performed important tasks while working in the GFD Prevention Bureau, in which he was responsible for the enforcement of fire laws and regulations; and conducted the fire inspections and abatement of existing and potential fire hazards. He continued on to work at other duties and served with the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Bureau, where he assisted with the administration of the EMS and Rescue Operations, along with the development of the EMS Division's goals and objectives. He was also responsible for overseeing the programs and services relative to the suppression and extinguishment of all the fire incidents on Guam; and

WHEREAS, in March of 1997, Chief Wusstig attained the rank of Battalion Fire Chief, and he planned, organized, and directed the operations, training and maintenance of fire companies and medic units on assigned platoons. Additionally, he had been appointed to oversee the Suppression, and the EMS and Rescue Divisions; and
