1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Mr. Jose Leon Guerrero Cruz was born on December 2,
4 1927; and he was called to his eternal rest on Thursday, October 2, 2014, at the age of
5 eighty-seven (87); and

1 **WHEREAS**, the late Mr. Jose Leon Guerrero Cruz married †Rosa Taison Cruz,
2 his wife of forty-five (45) years, on May 5, 1956; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Mr. Jose Leon Guerrero Cruz and †Rosa Taison Cruz
4 were blessed with eight (8) children: *Frank, Joseph, Lorraine, Marie, Elizabeth, Bert,*
5 *Lucille, and Raymond*; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in 1946, at the young age of nineteen (19), the late Mr. Jose Leon
7 Guerrero Cruz served with the Guam Combat Patrol, the first civilian operated Guam
8 Insular Patrol Force, a unit specializing in hunting Japanese stragglers who refused to
9 surrender even though the war was officially over. From 1949 to 1952, the late Mr.
10 Jose Leon Guerrero Cruz served with the Guam Police Department of Public Safety as
11 a police officer; and

12 **WHEREAS**, on October 20, 1952 to September 7, 1954, the late Mr. Jose Leon
13 Guerrero Cruz enlisted into the United States Army and served two tours with the 32nd
14 Infantry Regiment in the Korean Conflict as an Infantryman where he earned the
15 Combat Infantryman's Badge, he was proudly awarded the Purple Heart, along with
16 the United Nations Service Medal and the Korean Service Medal with two Bronze
17 service Stars and the National Defense Service Medal. After completion of his service
18 in the United States Army, he briefly served at the College of Guam (now the
19 University of Guam) and at the Naval Hospital Galley as a Steward attendant in the
20 early 1960's and subsequently retired; now therefore, be it


21 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
