3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Daniel “Danny” A. Orlino is a United States Air Force**
4 **Vietnam Veteran. He is married to Anita Flores, and together they are blessed with**
5 **four (4) beautiful children and seventeen (17) wonderful grandchildren; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Danny Orlino has continued in his musical career, and has
2 become a renowned recording artist and songwriter of numerous English and
3 *Chamorro* songs. He has written and performed a patriotic song, “77 Heroes of
4 Vietnam”, which was dedicated to the fallen *Chamorro* servicemen who lost their
5 lives in Vietnam; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in January 2011, Mr. Orlino participated in the Hawaii Regional
7 Veterans Creative Arts Festival and he won his first Gold Medal; and he is the first
8 *Chamorro* Air Force Veteran to do that. He went on to win a Bronze Medal at the
9 National Veterans Creative Arts Festival in the U.S., and his winning song for this
10 award was “Some Gave All” by Billy Ray Cyrus; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in January of 2013 and in 2014, Mr. Orlino participated again in
12 the Hawaii Regional and National Veterans Creative Arts Festival and garnered his
13 second and third Gold Medals, for singing “My Girl” by the Temptations and
14 “Country Road” by John Denver. The National Veterans Creative Arts Festival is a
15 culmination of talent competitions in art, drama, dance, and music for Veterans treated
16 in the U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs national health care system; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Orlino had placed first amongst thousands of fellow Veterans
18 that were selected winners of year-long, national fine arts talent competitions; and he
19 has since then been invited back to perform his winning song, “Country Road.” This
20 annual competition recognizes the progress and recovery made through therapy, and
21 raises the visibility of the creative achievements of our nation’s Veterans; now
22 therefore, be it
