1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN*:**

3        **WHEREAS**, Mr. Theodoro P. Padua has dedicated over thirty-three (33) years  
4        of public service with the government of Guam, of which twenty-four (24) years were  
5        dedicated to serving as a Deputy Marshal with the Judiciary of Guam; and

6        **WHEREAS**, Mr. Padua started his career at the Judiciary in 1990; and he  
7        understands hard work and dedication. He has gained invaluable work experience

1 working in the court's administration, and as a law enforcement officer at the  
2 Judiciary; and he has contributed to our island community by upholding the peace and  
3 protection for the people of Guam as a law enforcement official; and

4 **WHEREAS**, throughout his career, Mr. Padua continued to invest in his  
5 education, earning an Associate's Degree in Public Administration and a Bachelor's  
6 Degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Guam. He also dedicated his time  
7 working in the private sector to fulfill his goal of owning a home for his family, and  
8 did so at the age of thirty (30). During this time, he was appointed to serve as a  
9 member of the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board by the late Honorable Ricky  
10 Bordallo, former Governor; and he later served as its Chairman; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in 1988, Mr. Padua decided to return to working in the public  
12 sector, and he graduated with the twenty-ninth Guam Police Cycle and made the ranks  
13 to become a Police Officer II before leaving to work for the Judicial Branch; and there  
14 he continued in his law enforcement career serving as a Deputy Marshal II with the  
15 Judiciary. He was instrumental in the development and implementation of the hand  
16 book and test questionnaires for the private process servers; the Fugitive Files; and the  
17 Traffic Violator Programs. He worked closely with the KUAM and PNC media  
18 personnel, while updating standard operating procedures for the various sections of  
19 the Marshals Division; and

20 **WHEREAS**, throughout his career, Mr. Padua had garnered the respect of his  
21 colleagues and peers, and he has received numerous Letters of Commendations for his  
22 excellent work and professionalism. He has also been a positive role model amongst  
23 his colleagues, as he always encouraged his colleagues to perform their duties in a  
24 professional and exceptional manner; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Padua's service to the people of Guam also extends outside  
26 of his employment at the Judiciary. He has engaged himself in community projects,

1 such as the “Walk for Mankind” fundraisers for the United Nations Children’s Fund  
2 (UNICEF); and he has contributed to the United Service Organization (USO); now  
3 therefore, be it


4 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
