3 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, Incorporated was established in 1971 by Father Robert
4 Phelps and Mr. Luis Martinez, who recognized the importance of providing youth-
5 oriented programs and services on Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the primary mission of Sanctuary, Incorporated is “Helping Youth
7 and Families Help Themselves”; and

1 **WHEREAS**, since its creation, Sanctuary, Incorporated has remained at the
2 forefront of providing comprehensive services to runaway, homeless, and troubled
3 youth, and their families; and

4 **WHEREAS**, throughout the years, Sanctuary, Incorporated has continued to
5 expand its programs to better address the needs of our island's children who confront
6 many difficult issues, such as: physical and emotional abuse, sexual abuse, gang
7 involvement, negative peer pressure, and substance abuse; and has continued to help
8 in providing a firm foundation that will assist children and youth to be better able to
9 face the challenges of the future; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, Incorporated, which is an organization accredited by
11 the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities, strives to implement
12 programs, initiatives, and services that help our youth and families remain intact, to
13 include: crisis intervention; a 24-hour crisis hotline; a co-ed emergency shelter; a
14 transitional living program; client advocacy; case management services; aftercare; the
15 *Sagan Na'Homlo Para I Manhoben* program for youth battling chemical dependency;
16 the *Ayuda Para I Komunitad* AmeriCorps Program; the Youth Embracing Sanctuary
17 (YES) Crew youth development program; the Community Outreach Prevention,
18 Education and Development (COPED) Department; the parenting skills group; a
19 parent support group; adult anger management; youth anger management; tobacco
20 cessation for youth; the self-esteem group; drug and alcohol groups; and HIV/STD
21 testing and education; and for many years, Sanctuary, Incorporated has instilled
22 values, built character, and provided education to the youth of Guam, and their
23 families; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, Incorporated encourages island residents to join in
25 various events throughout the month of November 2014 to help educate others about
26 the services provided by Sanctuary, Incorporated; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, Incorporated is hosting its Third (3rd) Annual Blue
2 Carpet Gala to honor its top three (3) supporters of the year in the individual, business,
3 and partner categories; and

4 **WHEREAS**, November 2014 will mark the Forty-third (43rd) Year Anniversary
5 of the establishment of Sanctuary, Incorporated; now therefore, be it
