1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Ignacio Crisostomo Mesngon, Jr., better known as Inas, was born
4 on March 26, 1954. He is the second child of Carmen Acosta Crisostomo and Ignacio
5 Kisa Mesngon, Sr.; and his siblings are Margarita Manglona, †Mariano Mesngon,

1 Carmelita M. Campos, Beatrice M. Wedemeyer, Antonita Mesngon, †Antonio
2 Mesngon, Enrique Mesngon, Cristina Mesngon, Luis Mesngon, and Peter John
3 Mesngon; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Inas attended Cathedral Grade School, *Adelup* Elementary
5 School, *Barrigada* Junior High School, and George Washington Senior High School,
6 where he graduated in 1973; and

7 **WHEREAS**, after graduating from high school, Inas attended the Guam
8 Community College, where he obtained a Certification in Wastewater Technology;
9 and

10 **WHEREAS**, while working on his certification, Inas started working at his first
11 job with HIGA Packing Company. He later was employed with Ada's Seiyu; and
12 from 1976 to 1981, Inas worked with the Foremost Company; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Inas found the love of his life in Margaret Ann Cepeda
14 Quintanilla; and with the blessing of her mother, the late +Josefina Cepeda
15 Quintanilla, they were married on June 19, 1976, at the Immaculate Heart of Mary
16 Catholic Church in *Toto*, Guam; and

17 **WHEREAS**, on July 31, 1976, Inas and Margaret became proud parents as they
18 were blessed with welcoming their first-born son, Joseph Anthony into the world; and
19 eleven (11) months later, they were again blessed with having their first, and only
20 daughter, Ana Maria, who was born on June 20, 1977; and

21 **WHEREAS**, in 1981, Inas began his career with the government of Guam,
22 working as a Trades Helper at the former Public Utilities Agency of Guam (PUAG),
23 which is now the Guam Waterworks Authority; and

1 **WHEREAS**, after working for many years and growing in experience with the
2 government of Guam, Inas took on various promotions and awards; and he ultimately
3 was given the position and responsibility to serve as a Pumping Station Supervisor;
4 and

5 **WHEREAS**, as Pumping Station Supervisor, Inas enjoyed working at the
6 Northern, Central and Southern District Sewage Stations, where he ensured that
7 Guam’s wastewater did not go without proper treatment; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Inas’ ability to treat all employees equitably under his leadership,
9 and advocating for his subordinates when communicating with his management staff,
10 was seen as a great characteristic that enabled the workers to rely on his skills and
11 trainings as a way to effectively execute any plan in the event of any emergency; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Inas’ love for his job was evident as he would leave his family
13 and home, and report to work as early as 4:30 in the morning; and many times he
14 would remain at work during the numerous typhoons Guam had experienced; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Inas was also involved in the PUAG Employees Association as a
16 member of the Rambo’s Softball Team, where the employees would build teamwork
17 and build camaraderie with other teams; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Inas and Margaret joyfully welcomed their sons: Raymond
19 Ignacio, on January 27, 1985; and Mark Edward, on December 18, 1986; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Inas was actively involved in the educational lives of his children
21 attending every Parent-Teacher Conference, and participating in many school
22 organizations, such as: the J.Q. San Miguel Elementary School Parent Teacher
23 Association; the Junior Police Cadets Program; the L.P. Untalan Middle School Parent

1 Teacher Association; and the George Washington High School Parent Teacher
2 Student Alumni Association; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Inas now retires after thirty-three (33) years of dedicated service
4 to the people of Guam while working at the Guam Waterworks Authority; and he will
5 now enjoy retirement with his family, especially his grandchildren whom he dearly
6 loves: Josiah Gabriel, Antwaan Deshaun, Elijah Ignacio, Nathaniel Evan, Damon
7 Antonio, his *kiridu* Liam Ray, and princess Kamaryn Marie; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Inas will also further enjoy life's blessings with his son and
9 daughters-in-law: Rod Brown, Mary Therese Cruz, and Jocelyn Cachero Mesngon;
10 and

11 **WHEREAS**, Inas will continue to work with his community and continue in
12 his service at the *Dulce Nombre de Maria* Cathedral-Basilica Parish, where he serves
13 as a Hospitality Minister, a Choir Member, and a Lay Eucharistic Minister, while
14 extending his love for God and his people; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Inas' "Honey Do List" now grows beyond measure as his wife,
16 Margaret, will ensure that he is always occupied, but will still be enjoying his
17 retirement; now therefore, be it

4 Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.


