4 **years of service to the government of Guam, at the Guam Fire Department. He will be**

1 **WHEREAS**, he started his career in 1978 with the Guam Fire Department as a
2 Firefighter I and then unto the U.S. Naval Fire Department, as a Crash and Rescue
3 Firefighter, where he worked the ranks and divisions to become Fire Inspector in
4 1985; and

5 **WHEREAS**, In 1987, Mr. Duenas continued his career as the Occupational
6 Safety and Health (OSH) Safety Specialist with the U.S. Naval Ship Repair Facility,
7 Guam and progressed on to become the Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) Safety
8 Manager for the U.S. Naval Hospital, and the Fleet and Industrial Supply Center,
9 Guam thereafter. During this time, he was occasionally assigned as Shift Acting
10 Commander, where he arranged plans for manpower and duty assignments. He
11 primed federal safety programs for the hospital, supply, and shipyard facilities. In
12 addition, he proposed pertinent required actions for diverse work situations, certified
13 work schedules and records, and administered various staff training; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Duenas served as President of the Command Morale and
15 Welfare organization where he was very cogent and efficient in engaging others to
16 participate in various fundraising events and other work related functions; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Duenas served as Vice President for the Marianas Field
18 Safety and Health Organization and occasionally provided educational presentations
19 and demonstrations. He advocated community awareness and fostered compliance
20 with regulatory requirements, as well as entertained the many citizen requests and
21 concerns appropriated; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Duenas has gained over thirty (30) years of managerial and
23 supervisory experience in the fire and safety fields, he is a Nationally certified Safety
24 Officer – Safety Manager, and a member of the World Safety Organization; now
