WHEREAS, the members of the FLAG Board of Trustees are: Annie

WHEREAS, the members of FLAG have dedicated their time, efforts, and resources in serving the community of Guam since the time the organization has been implemented; and

WHEREAS, the Association has contributed to the development of distinct landmarks on our island, such as their donations to help in the building of the Guam Heroes Memorial Park at Skinner Plaza, the statue for Two Lovers Point Park, Our Lady of Camarin Statue in *Merizo*, and the restoration of *Azotea* in the *Plaza de España*. The organization has also contributed to the development of the infrastructure at the St. Dominic Senior Care Home Facility, bus shelters along Marine Corps Drive, and the *Agaña* Swimming Pool; and 1 WHEREAS, FLAG made a positive impact to our community through their contributions to the University of Guam (UOG) in providing a continuing scholarship 2 3 program, to the Guam Police Department in providing for the expenses of a delegate to attend the Crime Prevention Convention in Kentucky, and to the 20th Air Force 4 5 Association in assisting in the construction of a monument to preserve world history. 6 The association also donated to the UOG Fieldhouse Dance Studio, Gymnastic for 7 Youth of the Marianas, Archbishop Felixberto Flores Memorial, Santa Barabara New Church Building Fund, American Cancer Society's Relay for Life, Rigalu Foundation 8 9 and to the Banda Society of Guam for the purchase of musical instruments; and
