2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** on March 21, 1988, Albert Salas Buendicho began his
4 government of Guam career in public service to the people of Guam, working as a
5 Recreational Leader I at the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) under the
6 leadership of Mrs. Rita Q. Artero, Youth Center Supervisor. Mr. Buendicho very

7 much enjoyed working with youth, and he remained in this capacity at DPR until
8 January 25, 1991; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Buendicho then transferred to the Department of Youth
10 Affairs (DYA) on January 28, 1991, and was promoted to the position of Youth
11 Service Worker I, where he faithfully served; and he again proved himself worthy and
12 swiftly worked his way through the ranks; and

13 **WHEREAS**, eventually, Mr. Buendicho was successfully promoted to the
14 position of Youth Service Worker II after serving for only two (2) years and nine (9)
15 months in his previous capacity, having served with dedication, commitment and a
16 spirit of teamwork and cooperation, as evidenced by his performance on the job, the
17 extensive training he received, and his record of achievement; and his was a well-
18 deserved promotion; and

19 **WHEREAS**, on June 25, 1993, Mr. Buendicho graduated from the 1st
20 Correctional Officer Training Cycle of the Guam Community College Criminal
21 Justice Academy; and he was presented with a certificate of successful completion by
22 GCC President John T. Cruz; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Buendicho reached the pinnacle of his law enforcement
24 career with his culminating promotion to the position of Youth Service Supervisor by
25 DYA Director Ed Fortier on July 3, 1996; and

26 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Buendicho was widely recognized as a public servant who
27 went above and beyond the call of duty to ensure that public services were provided
28 effectively and efficiently, as evidenced by the EXCEL Award he was presented with
29 in October 1999 for "Supervisor of the Year" by Governor Carl T.C. Gutierrez; and

30 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Buendicho honorably assumed his leadership position with

31 the Department of Youth Affairs, and he made invaluable contributions as the
32 appointed Response Activity Coordinator (RAC)/Emergency Support Function (ESF)
33 of the Guam Office of Homeland Security/Office of Civil Defense (OCD) by Director
34 Christopher M. Dueñas, beginning with the TOP OFFICIALS 4 (TOPOFF4)
35 Exercises via Executive Order No. 2007-12, signed and promulgated by Governor
36 Felix P. Camacho on September 12, 2007. From that moment on, until near the end of
37 his successful career, Mr. Buendicho continued to diligently represent his Department
38 well at all the notable trainings in his distinct capacity, from November 2006 until
39 January 2015; and

40 **WHEREAS**, after devoting over thirty-five (35) years of his life to public
41 service with the government of Guam, and more recently as the DYA Youth Service
42 Supervisor, Mr. Albert Salas Buendicho officially retired from the Department of
43 Youth Affairs on January 23, 2015; now therefore, be it

44 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
45 *LiheSlaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I LiheSlaturan Guåhan* and the people
46 of Guam, commend and congratulate DYA Youth Service Supervisor, Mr. Albert
47 Salas Buendicho, and his family, on the occasion of his retirement after serving for
48 more than thirty-five (35) years with the government of Guam; and does further
49 extend a warm *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to him for his exemplary public
50 service to the people of Guam and the Department of Youth Affairs; and be it further
