- 10 Affairs (DYA) on January 28, 1991, and was promoted to the position of Youth
- 11 Service Worker I, where he faithfully served; and he again proved himself worthy and
- swiftly worked his way through the ranks; and
- WHEREAS, eventually, Mr. Buendicho was successfully promoted to the
- position of Youth Service Worker II after serving for only two (2) years and nine (9)
