3        **WHEREAS, “Cancer Survivors’ Day” is a celebration for all those who**  
4        **survive the challenges of cancer, endure hardships, and fight everyday battles yet,**  
5        **continue to inspire those who experience other life-threatening events in their lives;**  
6        **and**

1           **WHEREAS**, the survivors are an inspiration for those recently diagnosed, a  
2 cadre of strong-willed individuals, a gathering of support for families, and a testament  
3 of life and love in the form of outreach to the community; and

4           **WHEREAS**, the theme, “Hope, Triumph and Unbreakable Spirit of Cancer  
5 Survivors” is meant to promote the dignity and determination of all cancer survivors:  
6 bringing hope to the world, triumph for their challenges and building an unbreakable  
7 spirit as they forge on with the love of their families, their caregivers and other  
8 survivors affected by this disease; and

9           **WHEREAS**, it is known that cancer does not discriminate and knows no limits,  
10 often crippling the family at the start before instilling unwavering faith and support for  
11 one another. Cancer is infectious in that it affects the entire being of a loved one,  
12 impacts our community and reaches throughout the world; and

13           **WHEREAS**, adversity does not suffice in describing the horrors of cancer, and  
14 the pain of the survivor is felt by family and friends who inherently love, care, and  
15 want to relieve the hardships of this disease; and

16           **WHEREAS**, the inner survivors, fighting cancer every day, show us what true  
17 strength really is, demonstrating an appreciation for life that many fail to recognize  
18 and practice themselves; and

19           **WHEREAS**, many who live with cancer are faced with financial struggles,  
20 complicated access to medical care, and the lack of support and community  
21 awareness; and

22           **WHEREAS**, when our island community stands with each cancer patient, we  
23 reveal an invaluable sense of compassion to bring awareness to our community,  
24 reinforce the foundation of strong support systems, and better empathize with those  
25 who experience cancer first hand; and

26           **WHEREAS**, beyond the compassion shown by family and caregivers,  
27 numerous organizations make it their daily mission to provide support for greater

1 health and wellness to all cancer patients in their fight, fostering hope with their  
2 organizational abilities; and

3 **WHEREAS**, hundreds of our island’s people who have fought hard, have fallen  
4 to this disease; and the thousands of our family members who have stood by in care  
5 and support continue to motivate those who continually fight this disease; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the innate resilience of our island people is no better  
7 demonstrated than by cancer survivors, who unabashedly remind us of the true value  
8 of time; now therefore, be it

9 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*  
10 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
11 of Guam, commend and congratulate all our cancer survivors and their caregivers for


