**Relative to recognizing and extending *Un Dângkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'âse'* to Chief of Police Fred E. Bordallo, Jr., on the special occasion of his retirement after twenty-nine (29) years of government of Guam service with the Guam Police Department; and to further extending best wishes to him in his future endeavors, on behalf of *I Liheslatura* and the people of Guam.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS,** Chief of Police Fred E. Bordallo, Jr. has dedicated twenty-nine  
4 (29) years of service in the government of Guam while working at the Guam Police  
5 Department (GPD). He is the son of †Fred E. Bordallo, Sr., a prominent former  
6 lawyer and Annie Underwood Bordallo, a registered nurse with the *Sagua Mañagu*

7 Birth Center. He will be celebrating his retirement with Lily Cruz Bordallo, his wife  
8 of twenty-seven (27) years; and his four (4) children: Joseph, Fred III, Joleen, and  
9 Monique; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in February of 1986, Fred began his government of Guam career  
11 serving with the Guam Police Department after graduating from the 27<sup>th</sup> Police  
12 Recruit Training Cycle. His first assignment was with the Central Precinct Command,  
13 where he worked for nine years as a Patrol Officer within the Neighborhood Patrol  
14 Division; and during this assignment, he received his first promotion to the rank of  
15 Police Officer II; and

16 **WHEREAS**, in 1992, Fred transferred to the Traffic Investigations Section and  
17 Criminal Investigations Division, where he gained the experience as a traffic  
18 investigator; and he received numerous training certifications for basic traffic  
19 reconstruction and several traffic enforcement specializations, such as the  
20 Standardized Field Sobriety Test (SFST) and Traffic Speed Detection Radar. During  
21 this assignment, he was promoted to the rank of Police Officer III; and

22 **WHEREAS**, in 1995, Chief Bordallo was assigned to the Internal Affairs  
23 Section, where he attained the experience as an investigator with administrative  
24 investigation cases against GPD employees. Chief Bordallo served with the Internal  
25 Affairs Section from 1995 to 1998, and he was promoted to the rank of Police  
26 Sergeant in 1998; and

27 **WHEREAS**, from 1998 to 2001, while serving as a Police Sergeant in the  
28 Neighborhood Patrol Division, Chief Bordallo assumed the duties of Shift Supervisor,  
29 Operations Sergeant and Deputy Precinct Commander at the Southern Precinct  
30 Command; and

31 **WHEREAS**, from 2001 through 2010, Fred served in various divisions  
32 throughout the Guam Police Department; and while he was assigned as the Operations

33 Chief for the Administration Division, he was promoted to the rank of Police Captain  
34 in 2009; and

35 **WHEREAS**, throughout his years of diligent law enforcement duties, Chief  
36 Bordallo had received numerous Letters of Appreciation and Commendations for his  
37 commitment, loyalty and exemplary service. He has also received the Meritorious  
38 Service Award and the Distinguished Service Award for his superior performance and  
39 dedication to duty; and

40 **WHEREAS**, in January 2011, Governor Edward J.B. Calvo appointed Captain  
41 Bordallo to serve as the Chief of Police, and the 31<sup>st</sup> Guam Legislature confirmed  
42 Chief Bordallo in February 2011; and

43 **WHEREAS**, throughout all his years of service with GPD, Chief Bordallo  
44 sought a college education and he obtained an Associate of Science degree in  
45 Criminal Justice with an emphasis on Law Enforcement Administration from the  
46 Guam Community College, and a Bachelors and Masters degree in Public  
47 Administration from the University of Guam. He also completed two additional  
48 graduate education programs - the University of Oklahoma studies towards a Masters  
49 degree in Human Relations, and graduation with cohort 1201/1202 Masters Homeland  
50 Security curriculum at the Naval Postgraduate School Center for Homeland Defense  
51 & Security Study; and

52 **WHEREAS**, Chief Bordallo has over sixteen (16) years of military service. He  
53 served with the United States Marine Corps, U.S. Naval Reserves with specialty  
54 training in correctional security and physical base security, and he completed service  
55 as a U.S. Army Reservist with the 368<sup>th</sup> Military Police Company; and

56 **WHEREAS**, besides investing his time with his work as Chief of Police, Fred  
57 dedicates a great amount of time reading and building a collection of books. He is  
58 also known to many of his friends and colleagues as a “bookworm.” A quote he will

59 frequently state is from Mark Twain: “The man who does not read good books has no  
60 advantage over the man who can’t read them”; and

61 **WHEREAS**, Chief Bordallo believes in the importance of community  
62 involvement, and he serves with the Young Men’s League of Guam; he was a Board  
63 Member of the Guam Humanities Council; and he still serves with Guam’s Systems of  
64 Care and Guam’s Peace Council; now therefore, be it

65 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*  
66 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
67 of Guam, recognize and extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to Chief of Police  
68 Fred E. Bordallo, Jr., on the special occasion of his retirement after twenty-nine (29)  
69 years of government of Guam service with the Guam Police Department; and does  
70 further extend best wishes to him in his future endeavors; and be it further


71 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules


