1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS**, on October 1, 1962, President John F. Kennedy designated May  
4 15 as a day to commemorate peace officers nationwide for their dedication and service  
5 in the protection and service of our citizens from criminal disparity, and for providing  
6 public safety to the people throughout the nation; and

1           **WHEREAS**, on this special day, the people of Guam and the nation come  
2 together to honor and recognize the heroic men and women who have devoted their  
3 lives to enforcing the laws and to protecting the people from injustice; and

4           **WHEREAS**, peace officers throughout the island risk their lives to protect and  
5 serve the community, as they commit themselves to upholding the law. By answering  
6 the call of duty, some of these brave men and women pay the ultimate price, which is  
7 an enormous sacrifice and loss to the people of Guam; and

8           **WHEREAS**, our island community will observe “Peace Officers’ Memorial  
9 Day” on May 15, 2015, which is a day to acknowledge the uniformed men and  
10 women who have served in the line of duty to protect the life and property of the  
11 people of Guam; and

12           **WHEREAS**, the following individuals have served as peace officers and have  
13 given their lives: Conservation Officer Francisco M. Isezaki; Patrolman Francisco D.  
14 Taitague; Patrolman Juan M. Santos; Drug Enforcement Administration Special  
15 Agent Larry D. Wallace; Police Officer I Francisco A. Reyes; Police Officer III  
16 Tomas M. Sablan; Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve Helen K. Lizama; Civilian  
17 Volunteer Police Reserve Rudy C. Iglesias; Police Officer I Raymond S. Sanchez;  
18 Police Officer I Manuel A. Aquino; Police Lieutenant Francisco C. Toves;  
19 Corrections Officer I Douglas W. Mashburn; Police Officer I Eddie A. Santos; United  
20 States Air Force Airman Laurie Lucas; United States Air Force Sergeant Stacey E.  
21 Levay; Police Sergeant I Frankie E. Smith; and Police Sergeant I Seigfred D. Mortera;

23           **WHEREAS**, may we honor and uphold the legacy set forth by these  
24 courageous uniformed men and women of law enforcement who gave their lives to  
25 ensure the welfare of our island and our nation; and

1           **WHEREAS**, an important aspect of “Peace Officers’ Memorial Day” is the  
2 recognition of the family members of these fallen officers, and how the island  
3 community appreciates their continued support to their loved ones; now therefore, be  
4 it

5           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*  
6 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
7 of Guam, extend a special tribute and honor to Guam’s men and women in uniform  
8 who have paid the ultimate sacrifice while serving as peace officers and protecting the  
9 people of Guam in the line of duty; and does further extend appreciation to the family  
10 members who provided support to these officers, as we commemorate “Peace  
11 Officers’ Memorial Day” on May 15, 2015; and be it further

12           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules  
13 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of  
14 the same be thereafter transmitted to the Families of the Fallen Heroes; to the Chief of  
15 Police, Guam Police Department; to the Director, Department of Corrections; to the  
16 Director, Department of Agriculture; to the Drug Enforcement Administration, Guam;  
17 to the United States Air Force, Guam; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I*  
18 *Maga'lahen Guåhan*.


