3           **WHEREAS, Mr. Robert H. Malay, also affectionately known as “Robb” came**  
4 **to Guam twenty-two years ago and in 1993 began working with the Department of**

1 Education teaching physical education and health courses for students in grades 6<sup>th</sup> to  
2 8<sup>th</sup> grade sat Dededo Middle School and also served as their Director from 1994-1995;  
3 and

4 **WHEREAS**, from 1996 to 2005, Robb was a teacher at Simon Sanchez High  
5 School teaching physical education and health courses for students in grades 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>  
6 grades; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Robb also worked at the University of Guam from 1999-2003 as  
8 an Adjunct Professor teaching various courses in Health, Physical Education,  
9 Recreation and Dance Department; and

10 **WHEREAS**, from 1994-2004, Robb was a mentoring teacher for the  
11 University of Guam Physical Education Majors; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in the numerous years Robb worked at the Department of  
13 Education, in addition to his teaching and administrative responsibilities, he was  
14 Assistant Coach for Boy's Volleyball at Dededo Middle School (1993-1994); Head  
15 Coach for Boys and Girl's Basketball at Dededo Middle School (1993-1996);  
16 Assistant Football Coach for John F. Kennedy High School and Simon Sanchez High  
17 School (1994-1997); Basketball Coach for Boys and Girl's Junior Varsity Basketball  
18 at Simon Sanchez High School (1995-1997); Head Coach for Boy's Varsity  
19 Basketball at Simon Sanchez High School (1997-2000); Head Coach for Girls Varsity  
20 Soccer at Simon Sanchez (2003); and Head Coach for Girl's Varsity Basketball at  
21 Simon Sanchez High School (1997-2004); and

22 **WHEREAS**, as a result of his devotion as a coach, Robb was awarded  
23 Basketball Coach of the year in 1997 and 1999 recognized by KTWG Radio; and was  
24 awarded Coach of the Year from Simon Sanchez High School in 1997 and 2003; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Robb was recognized for his leadership abilities and detailed to  
26 Assistant Principal, Simon Sanchez High School, from 2005 to 2008; from 2008 to

1 2011, Robb became Principal, Machananao Elementary School; was Acting Deputy  
2 Superintendent, Educational Support and Community Learning from 2011 to 2012;  
3 Deputy Superintendent, Assessment and Accountability from 2013 where he currently  
4 holds this position; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Robb was nominated into the Who's Who Among America's  
6 Teachers in 1999, 2002, and 2003; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in 2000, Robb was a nominee for Teacher of the Year; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Robb currently holds a team member position for several  
9 committees, such as the Intervention/Integrated Services Delivery Leadership Team;  
10 Special Education Review Committee; Board Policy Review Committee; Negotiating  
11 Team for Board of Education/Union Contract; Superintendent Transition Team;  
12 Educational Learning Task Force: *Lani Kate Protehi Protehi Y Famagu'on-ta* Task  
13 Force for Youth Victims of Sexual Abuse; Guam Advisory Panel for Students with  
14 Disabilities; System of Care Management Committee; District Coordinator Guam  
15 Teacher of the Year; Accreditation Committee (Western Alliance of Schools and  
16 Colleges; District Assignment of Attendance Areas Committee; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Robb was also a team member and Chairperson of the Regional  
18 Professional Development Conference (2008-2011); School Leaders Evaluation  
19 Committee; Regional Task Force (2008-2011); Co-Chairperson of Physical Fitness  
20 Committee (2006-2008); Chief Negotiator for the Board of Education /Union Contract  
21 (2010-2011); and

22 **WHEREAS**, Robb was very active with the Guam Rugby Football Union  
23 where he was the Club Person of the Year (1999); Junior Rugby Development Officer  
24 (1999-2001); National Rugby 7's Team Member (1999, 2003); Team Captain Guam  
25 Geckos (2002); member of the Board of Directors (2002-2005); Team Captain (2002-

1 2008); Rugby Union Referee (2008-present); and President of the Referee’s Society  
2 (2009-2012);

3 **WHEREAS**, in 2000, Robb was the National Basketball Team Selector for the  
4 Guam Basketball Confederation; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in 2000, Robb participated in the Micronesian Basketball  
6 Tournament Gold Medal; and

7 **WHEREAS**, when Robb is not working hard for the Department of Education  
8 or involved in many community sports activities, he enjoys traveling and spending  
9 time with his wife, Sally and their three sons, Lucas, Nathan and Daniel; now

20 the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Mr.


