3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Daniel A. Brown began his tenure as a Park Ranger with the**
4 **War in the Pacific National Historical Park in September of 2009, where his duties**
5 **included management of the park's permitting program, the presentation of hundreds**

1 of original programs on detailed World War II history and its significance, and the
2 management of park resources and increasing visitor understanding, appreciation, and
3 satisfaction; and

4 **WHEREAS**, after serving with the World War II Valor in the Pacific National
5 Monument in Honolulu, Hawaii, Mr. Daniel A. Brown assumed the position of Park
6 Guide with the War in the Pacific National Historical Park in February until May of
7 2014, during which time he performed as the Park's front-line ambassador to hundreds
8 of visitors weekly, constantly projecting a positive, professional image and attitude;
9 he independently researched, developed, and presented original programs on detailed
10 Guam and World War II history, and conducted tours and talks to groups of all ages;
11 and he regularly contributed articles and posts on the National Park Service social
12 media; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in June of 2014, Mr. Daniel A. Brown was promoted to his
14 current position of Lead Park Ranger and he was responsible for the daily operations
15 of the Park Visitor Center, scheduling and communicating events, programs,
16 meetings, and other commitments, and providing information to Park visitors on
17 World War II history, the progression of the 1944 Battle of Guam, the sensitive
18 experiences of Pacific islanders during historic eras, and controversial natural resource
19 concerns, such as climate change and invasive species; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the War in the Pacific National Historical Park was established in
21 commemoration of all who participated in the Pacific Theater of WWII, particularly
22 the recapture of Guam and the liberation of the *Chamorro* people; and Mr. Daniel A.
23 Brown, during his tenure with the War in the Pacific National Historical Park,
24 provided countless residents and visitors with a better appreciation of the history of
25 WWII in the Pacific, and the bravery and sacrifice of those who were involved in that
26 campaign; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Daniel A. Brown, having served our nation and our island
2 well and faithfully with the War in the Pacific National Historical Park, will be
3 leaving Guam in June of 2015; now therefore, be it


4 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
