WHEREAS, Alicia Limtiaco is the first woman to serve as the United States

4 Attorney for the Districts of Guam and the Northern Mariana Islands; and

WHEREAS, in 2006, Alicia was also the first woman elected to serve as Attorney General of Guam. Prior to her tenure as Attorney General, she served as the acting Chief Prosecutor and was an Assistant Attorney General for the Office of the Attorney General of Guam. She was also the Lead Prosecutor of the Criminal Sexual Conduct and Family Violence Unit, and Co-chair of the Governor's Family Violence Task Force; and

WHEREAS, Alicia Limtiaco spearheaded certain initiatives, including the formation of task forces to address public school system health and safety, internet crimes against children, cyber-security and cyber-crime, gambling, human trafficking, and the implementation and compliance of the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA) requirements by the government of Guam; and

WHEREAS, in addition, Alicia has over eight years of private law practice experience during which time she handled civil litigation, criminal, family law, juvenile and probate matters; and she has served as the Ninth Circuit Lawyer Representative for the District of Guam, as a Judicial Extern with the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California, and as a Law Clerk for the Superior Court of Guam; and

WHEREAS, U.S. Attorney Limtiaco received her Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration from the University of Southern California (USC) in 1985; and her Juris Doctorate from the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA) School of Law in 1990; and

1 WHEREAS, U.S. Attorney Limtiaco served as Adjunct Faculty and Assistant

2 Professor with the University of Guam, College of Professional Studies, School of

3 Business and Public Administration for over seven years; and served with the Guam

5 for over six years, training Guam's future law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, throughout her successful career, Alicia has received numerous awards and commendations from various organizations, such as, the "Outstanding Woman of the Year" for 1999; and she is included in the *I Manfayi*: Who's Who in *Chamorro* History." In May 2012, she was honored as the "Soroptimist Founder Region Ruby Award" recipient in California, an award which acknowledges women who are working to improve the lives of women and girls through their personal or professional activities; and

WHEREAS, in March 2013, Alicia was the recipient of the "Visionary Voice Award," presented by the National Sexual Violence Resource Center. This award was offered as part of the "Sexual Assault Awareness Month" campaign, and honored individuals throughout the country who are doing outstanding work in the field of anti-sexual violence within their communities; and
