1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN***
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS,** Alicia Anne Garrido Limtiaco presently serves as the United
4 States Attorney for the Districts of Guam and the Northern Mariana Islands. She was

1 nominated by President Barack Obama in February of 2010, and confirmed by the
2 Unites States Senate in April 2010; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Alicia Limtiaco is the first woman to serve as the United States
4 Attorney for the Districts of Guam and the Northern Mariana Islands; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in 2006, Alicia was also the first woman elected to serve as
6 Attorney General of Guam. Prior to her tenure as Attorney General, she served as the
7 acting Chief Prosecutor and was an Assistant Attorney General for the Office of the
8 Attorney General of Guam. She was also the Lead Prosecutor of the Criminal Sexual
9 Conduct and Family Violence Unit, and Co-chair of the Governor’s Family Violence
10 Task Force; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Alicia Limtiaco spearheaded certain initiatives, including the
12 formation of task forces to address public school system health and safety, internet
13 crimes against children, cyber-security and cyber-crime, gambling, human trafficking,
14 and the implementation and compliance of the Sex Offender Registration and
15 Notification Act (SORNA) requirements by the government of Guam; and

16 **WHEREAS**, in addition, Alicia has over eight years of private law practice
17 experience during which time she handled civil litigation, criminal, family law,
18 juvenile and probate matters; and she has served as the Ninth Circuit Lawyer
19 Representative for the District of Guam, as a Judicial Extern with the U.S. District
20 Court for the Central District of California, and as a Law Clerk for the Superior Court
21 of Guam; and

22 **WHEREAS**, U.S. Attorney Limtiaco received her Bachelor of Science Degree
23 in Business Administration from the University of Southern California (USC) in 1985;
24 and her Juris Doctorate from the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA)
25 School of Law in 1990; and

1 **WHEREAS**, U.S. Attorney Limtiaco served as Adjunct Faculty and Assistant
2 Professor with the University of Guam, College of Professional Studies, School of
3 Business and Public Administration for over seven years; and served with the Guam
4 Community College, Criminal Justice Program and Basic Law Enforcement Academy
5 for over six years, training Guam’s future law enforcement officers; and

6 **WHEREAS**, throughout her successful career, Alicia has received numerous
7 awards and commendations from various organizations, such as, the “Outstanding
8 Woman of the Year” for 1999; and she is included in the *I Manfayi: Who’s Who in*
9 *Chamorro History*.” In May 2012, she was honored as the “Soroptimist Founder
10 Region Ruby Award” recipient in California, an award which acknowledges women
11 who are working to improve the lives of women and girls through their personal or
12 professional activities; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in March 2013, Alicia was the recipient of the “Visionary Voice
14 Award,” presented by the National Sexual Violence Resource Center. This award was
15 offered as part of the “Sexual Assault Awareness Month” campaign, and honored
16 individuals throughout the country who are doing outstanding work in the field of
17 anti-sexual violence within their communities; and

18 **WHEREAS**, in September 2013, Alicia was the recipient of the Office of the
19 Secretary of Defense Employee Support of the Guard and Reserve (ESGR) “Patriotic
20 Employer” Award; and

21 **WHEREAS**, in March 2014, Alicia was honored at the Guam Women’s
22 Chamber of Commerce “Women Firsts Ceremony” commemorating Women’s
23 History Month, with the theme: “Celebrating Women of Character, Courage and
24 Commitment”; and

25 **WHEREAS**, most recently, in April 2015, U.S. Attorney Alicia Limtiaco was
26 honored as the recipient of the UCLA Asian Pacific Islander Law Students

1 Association (APILSA) “2015 Alumnus of the Year Award” at the UCLA APILSA
2 and Asian Pacific American Law Journal Alumni Banquet held at UCLA in Los
3 Angeles, California. She was recognized for her professional and personal
4 accomplishments and contributions to UCLA and the Asian and Pacific Islander
5 communities, and is the first Pacific Islander to receive the award; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Alicia celebrates her many accomplishments with her husband,
7 Vince Munoz, and their daughter, Julia Faye Munoz; as well as with her parents,
8 Francisco and Julia Limtiaco; now therefore, be it

9 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
10 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and congratulate the Honorable Alicia
11 A.G. Limtiaco on being distinguished as the “2015 Alumna of the Year” of the
12 University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA) School of Law’s Asian Pacific
13 Islander Law Students Association (APILSA); and does further extend *Un Dångkolo*
14 *Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to her for her commitment in dedicating her service and support
15 for the people of Guam and to Guam’s justice system; and be it further

17 the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the
