1 **WHEREAS**, Teresita Delos Reyesis married to Nonito Delos Reyes; and they
2 are blessed with five (5) children, and their spouses; and are also blessed with six (6)
3 grandchildren; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Teresita graduated in 1968 from John F. Kennedy High School in
5 *Tamuning*, Guam; and she then began her public service journey working as a Group
6 Insurance Specialist II under the Employee Benefits Branch of the Government of
7 Guam Department of Administration from January 16, 1990, to December 29, 1998.
8 She was then promoted and served as a Personnel Specialist I from December 30,
9 1998, to January 3, 2005; and she was once again promoted to Personnel Specialist II
10 on January 4, 2005, where she remained for the duration of her public service career;

12 **WHEREAS**, Teresita served the public with great compassion and integrity in
13 the Employee Benefits Branch by administering the life and health insurance benefits
14 in accordance with contractual agreements and statutes, ensuring for employees the
15 utmost confidentiality, and being an advocate for employees, retirees, survivors, and
