5 **the late Elpidio and Francisca Borrromeo; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Rolando’s educational pursuits include attending *Agaña* Heights
2 Elementary School, Agueda Johnston Middle School, and George Washington High
3 School, eventually graduating from the University of Guam in 1993 with a Bachelor
4 of Business Administration in Management degree. Rolando always took his
5 education seriously and always to heart, making his parents and family proud of his
6 accomplishments; and

7 **WHEREAS**, during his very busy career, Rolando met and married his soul-
8 mate and better half, Catalina Catherine “Cathy” Aguirre on May 3, 2003. When
9 Rolando went to work, he had nothing to worry about. Cathy effortlessly took care of
10 their children and the everyday affairs throughout their life, while serving as a
11 homemaker; and Rolando always felt extremely blessed. Rolando and Cathy are the
12 proud parents of two children – the eldest is a daughter, Riona; and a son, Kyle. Both
13 children have emulated the teachings and examples shown to them by their parents.

14 *Mongmong*; and


15 **WHEREAS**, Rolando has selflessly dedicated many years of his life in public

- 2 Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.


