1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, historically, Guam has been and continues to be a matriarchal
4 society where women are well respected, and where family is the cornerstone of our
5 community; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Annie Bordallo, one of Guam’s daughters and our island’s
2 first OB/GYN, envisioned a healthcare environment that is committed to the care and
3 compassionate service of Guam’s women and their families; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Bordallo and Dr. Ellen Bez, in the spirit of collaboration,
5 enlisted the support of family, friends, advisors and colleagues to make that vision a
6 reality with the development of *Sagua Mañagu*, Guam’s first birthing center; and

7 **WHEREAS**, fifteen (15) years ago, *Sagua Mañagu* officially opened its doors
8 and assisted with the birth of a beautiful baby girl; and in the years that have followed,
9 more than six thousand eight hundred (6,800) of Guam’s children were born at *Sagua*
10 *Mañagu*; and

11 **WHEREAS**, since its establishment, *Sagua Mañagu* has succeeded in fulfilling
12 its vision of being a family-oriented healthcare environment for childbirth on Guam,
13 thereby setting a new standard and creating higher patient expectations for health care;
14 now therefore, be it

15 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
16 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
17 of Guam, recognize *Sagua Mañagu*, Guam’s first birthing center, for fifteen (15) years
18 of excellent service as the first privately owned, privately financed healthcare facility
19 of its kind; and be it further


20 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules


