3 WHEREAS, in November 1971, the Guam Association of REALTORS® 4 became a part of the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR), then known as 5 the National Association of Real Estate Boards, which would become one of the 6 largest and most influential trade industries in the nation today; and

WHEREAS, to the present date, the Guam Association of REALTORS® has
grown with close to four hundred members strong; and is the constant "Voice for Real
Estate" on Guam. The GAR is proud to be part of the one million members of the
NAR; and

WHEREAS, the term REALTOR® is a registered collective membership trademark that identifies a real estate professional who is a member of the National Association of REALTORS® and subscribes to its strict Code of Ethics; and

WHEREAS, not all real estate licenses are the same; and only real estate licensees who are members of the NAR are properly called REALTORS®; they proudly display the REALTOR® logo on their business cards or other marketing and sales literature; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® are committed to treating all the parties to a real estate transaction with honesty; and they subscribe to a strict code of ethics and are expected to maintain a high level of knowledge of the process of buying and selling real estate. An independent survey reports that 84% of home buyers would use the same REALTOR® again; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® are very capable in determining a person's buying
 power and referring them to lenders who are best qualified to help them; and

1 WHEREAS, REALTORS® have many resources to assist others in searching 2 for homes, especially those not actively advertised in the market, and they will 3 thoroughly investigate to find all available properties; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® assist in the selection process by providing 4 5 objective information about each property, and they can provide the local community 6 with information on utilities, zoning, schools, and other important real estate data; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® help their clients to negotiate, including, but not 7 8 limited to, price, financing, terms, date of possession, and the inclusion or exclusion 9 of repairs and furnishings or equipment; and they can also advise as to which 10 investigations and inspections are recommended or required; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® provide due diligence during the evaluation of a 11 property; and depending on the area and the property, it could include inspections for 12 13 termites, dry rot, asbestos, faulty structure, roof condition, septic tank and well tests, just to name a few; they can also assist with finding qualified responsible 14 15 professionals to do most of the investigations and provide written reports. Along with 16 the title company or an attorney, the REALTOR® can help resolve issues that might 17 cause problems at a later date; and

18 WHEREAS, REALTORS® can help their clients to better understand different 19 financing options, and in identifying qualified lenders; and also guide them through 20 the closing process to make sure everything flows together smoothly; and

21 WHEREAS, when it comes to helping those interested in selling a home, 22 REALTORS® can provide up-to-date information on what is happening in the 23 marketplace; and the price, financing, terms and conditions of competing properties; 24 and

25 WHEREAS, REALTORS® will often recommend repairs or cosmetic work 26 that will significantly enhance the salability of a client's property, and they will market the property to other real estate agents and the public; and they act as the marketing coordinator, disbursing information about the property to other real estate agents through a Multiple Listing Service or other cooperative marketing networks, and coordinate open houses for agents, and others. The REALTOR® Code of Ethics requires REALTORS® to utilize these cooperative relationships when they benefit their clients; and

WHEREAS, REALTORS® know when, where and how to advertise a
property and can help a client to objectively evaluate every buyer's proposal without
compromising their marketing position. They can also help a client to write a legally
binding, win-win agreement that will be more likely to make it through the process;
and

WHEREAS, a REALTOR® can assist with the closing of the sale of a home, and is the best person to objectively help to resolve any issues and move the transaction to a final closing or settlement; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Association of REALTORS® has always been committed to promoting professionalism in the real estate business; and in line with such commitment, they have put forth a week-long educational opportunity for the REALTORS®. The Association believes in continuing education and in increasing the knowledge of its members about the real estate business, which will ultimately benefit the end consumers; now therefore, be it
